Resolution adopted by Board of Directors

January 12, 1912

WHEREAS, S. Z. de Ferranti has contributed in a high degree to the advancement of electrical development by his work in relation to the electric furnace, the electric-energy meter, the improvement of the alternating-current generator and motor, and especially by his remarkable pioneer work in high-tension alternating-current generation and distribution; and

WHEREAS, the Constitution of the American Institute of Electrical Engineers provides that by unanimous vote of all the members of the Board of Directors, Honorary Members may be chosen from among those who have rendered eminent services to electrical engineering or its allied sciences; it is
