

### BYLAWS OF THE ATLANTA SECTION OF THE INSTITUTE OF ELECTRICAL AND ELECTRONICS ENGINEERS ADOPTED $10 - \lambda 8 - 74$

#### ARTICLE I --- Name and Object

- Sec. 1. This organization shall be known as the Atlanta Section of the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers.
- Sec. 2. The Section shall strive for the advancement of the theory and practice of electrical engineering, electronics, radio, allied branches of engineering and of the related arts and sciences, and the maintenance of high professional standards among its members, all in consonance with the IEEE Constitution and Bylaws and with special attention to such aims within the territory of the Section as are hereinafter defined.
- Sec. 3. The Section shall hold meetings for the transaction of the regular business of the Section and for the presentation of papers and their discussion, and shall aid in promotion of close cooperation and good fellowship among its members.

#### ARTICLE II -- Membership

- Sec. 1. All members of the IEEE with IEEE mailing addresses within the territory of the Section are automatically members of this Section.
- Sec. 2. All Fellows, Senior Members, and Members of the IEEE with IEEE mailing addresses within the territory of the Section shall be entitled to attend the meetings, vote and hold office. Associates of the IEEE within the territory of the Section shall be entitled to attend meetings and vote, but shall not have the right to hold office.
- Sec 3. Student Members of IEEE shall be entitled to attend meetings but shall not have the right to vote or hold office.

#### ARTICLE III ---- Territory

Sec. 1. The Atlanta Section shall consist of all counties in the State of Georgia with the exception of the following:

#### ARTICLE IV — Finances

Sec. 1. There shall be no Section dues.

- Sec. 2. The ordinary expenses of the Section shall be defrayed by the funds supplied by the IEEE. Funds on hand in the Section Treasury, from whatever source derived, are the property of the IEEE, and shall not be used for purposes other than the normal operations of the Section, without prior authorization of the IEEE Executive Committee.
- Sec. 3. Emergency or extraordinary expenses may be provided for by voluntary contribution from the membership of the Section. A two-thirds vote of the Section Executive Committee is required before such a request may be made.
- Sec. 4. On the recommendation of the Chairman of the Section Membership and Transfers Committee the name of a non-IEEE member may be added to the mailing list to receive notices of Section activities. The name shall be added initially for a period of six months with provision for one extension of an additional six months period of time. If the individual has not applied for membership by the end of this one year period, his name shall be removed from the mailing list with the provision that it not be added as a nonmember for the next three years.

In addition to those non-IEEE members who receive Section notices in accordance with the foregoing paragraph, on the recommendation of the Section Chairman and the approval by the Regional Director, there may also be included individuals whose positions in the community make it desirable for them to be kept informed of IEEE activities. There shall be no time limit associated with continuation of names in this category on the mailing list, although the list shall be revised annually by the Chairman of the Section Membership and Transfer Committee. The Section Chairman shall report annually to the Regional Director concerning names on the Section mailing list which are in this category, and in the process of adding the name, as well as in the annual reporting, a brief statement should be provided justifying the inclusion of each name.

#### ARTICLE V ---- Officers

- Sec. 1. The officers of the Section shall be a Chairman, a Vice Chairman, a Secretary, and a Treasurer.
- Sec. 2. The terms of office for all officers shall begin at the close of the Annual Meeting, and shall continue until their successors are duly elected and take office.
- Sec. 3. The terms of office set forth shall be approximately one year and may exceed this interval only in the case where the date of the Annual Meeting is being changed and a continuation in office is necessary to effect the new schedule, or no successor has been elected or appointed.

#### ARTICLE VI ----- Management

- Sec. 1. There shall be a Section Executive Committee consisting of the officers, the Junior Past Chairman, the Chairman of the Program and Student Activities Committees, Chairman of Student Branches, one representative from each local chapter of an IEEE Group or Society, two directors elected at large under the same procedure as Section Officers, and ex-officio, the Chairman of each Subsection.
- Sec. 2. The Chairman, who is responsible to the Section Executive Committee, shall have general supervision of the affairs of the Section. He shall preside at meetings of the Section and the Section Executive Committee and have such other powers and perform such other duties as may be provided for in these Bylaws, or may be delegated to him by vote of the Section. In his absence, his duties shall be peformed by the Vice Chairman.
- Sec. 3. The Vice Chairman shall be responsible for the coordination of the standing committees of the Section. Chairman of these committees will report to the Vice Chairman. In addition, he shall maintain close cooperation with the Chairman and be cognizant of all Section activities.
- Sec. 4. The Secretary shall record the minutes of all meetings of the Section and of the Section Executive Committee. He shall make such reports of his activities as may be required by the IEEE Executive Committee.

- Sec. 5. The Secretary shall send out notices as required by the Executive Committee.
- Sec. 6. The Treasurer shall receive and deposit all monies in the name of the Section in such depository as shall be determined by the Section Executive Committee. He shall make only such disbursements as shall be ordered by the Section Executive Committee. He shall make such reports as may be required by the IEEE Executive Committee. Section financial records shall be maintained by the Treasurer.
- Sec. 7. The Executive Committee, as soon as expedient after the Annual Meeting, shall appoint Chairmen of the following standing committees:

Membership Program Student Activities Arrangements Public Relations Young Engineers

- Sec. 8. Other committees may be authorized by vote of the Section Executive Committee at any regular meeting with the Chairman of these committees appointed by the Section Chairman.
- Sec. 9. The Chairman of the Public Relations Committee shall be responsible for the publication of the <u>Atlanta Circuit</u> newsletter, to include meeting notices for the Section meetings and as many Group or Society Chapter or Subsection meetings as possible. The <u>Atlanta Circuit</u> shall be the official publication of the <u>Atlanta Section</u>.
- Sec.10. Members appointed to any Section committee shall serve until their successors are appointed or the committee is dissolved.

ARTICLE VII ---- Election of Officers

- Sec. 1. All officers and the two members at large of the Executive Committee shall be elected by letter ballot.
- Sec. 2. The Nominating Committee shall be composed of the four most recent Past Chairmen who are able and willing to serve. The Senior Past Chairman shall be chairman of the committee. The Section Chairman shall appoint the members of the Nominating Committee by January 1 of each year.
- Sec. 3. The Nominating Committee shall nominate one candidate for Chairman, one candidate for Vice Chairman, one candidate for Secretary, one candidate for Treasurer and four candidates for the two directors of the Executive Committee. These nominations shall be transmitted in

writing to the Executive Committee by February 1 of each year and shall be published in the February issue of <u>Atlanta</u> <u>Circuit</u> for distribution to all voting members. This issue of <u>Atlanta</u> <u>Circuit</u> shall also give all of the necessary details concerning nominations by petition, as contained in the following Section of these Bylaws.

- Sec. 4. Nominations for any or all offices and for the two members at large may be made by petition addressed to the Section Chairman, under the following provisions:
  - (A) Petitions must bear the personal signature of 25 voting members of the Atlanta Section.
  - (B) Petitions must be received by the Section Chairman prior to March 15 of each year.
- Sec. 5. The Secretary shall mail an official ballot, together with a pre-addressed return envelope to each voting member of the Atlanta Section of IEEE by April 1 of each year. This ballot shall contain the names and brief biographies of all nominees duly proposed in accordance with these Bylaws and one blank space below each nominee on the ballot, which space may be used by voting members for the purpose of voting for an alternate member. Ballots must be returned in the pre-addressed envelope not later than May 1 of each year to be counted. A Committee of three tellers shall be appointed by the Section Chairman prior to May 1 of each year. This Committee shall receive and count all ballots and submit a written tabulation of them to the Secretary by May 10 of each year. In case of a tie vote for any position on the ballot, it shall be resolved by a majority vote of the members of the Executive Committee at a special meeting called by the Chairman for that purpose. The Tellers Committee shall report their tabulation of the ballots to the annual meeting of the Section and the Chairman shall declare elected those nominees receiving the majority of the votes.
- Sec. 6. The Chairman of the Section shall inform the successful candidates of their election and arrange for the transfer of responsibility to the new officers at the Annual Meeting.
- Sec. 7. Vacancies in office occurring during the year shall be filled by the Section Executive Committee for the remainder of the unexpired term unless otherwise provided for.
- Sec. 8. If for any reason the best interests of the Section seem to require a change in the governing body during the year, the matter shall be duly and carefully considered by the Section Executive Committee. Upon not less than two-thirds

vote of the Section Executive Committee, or upon receipt by the Section Executive Committee of a petition signed by five percent of the members of the Section, recommendation shall be made to the Section for action at a special meeting to be duly called by the Section Executive Committee for the sole purpose of considering and voting upon such a change. A quorum must be established at this meeting.

Two-thirds vote of the members present shall be necessary to declare an office vacant. Upon two-thirds vote of the members present, the vacant office must be filled for the unexpired term as provided under Section 7.

#### ARTICLE VIII ---- Meetings

- Sec. 1. The Section'shall hold not less than five regular meetings during the year, one of which shall be an Annual Meeting.
- Sec. 2. The Annual Meeting shall be held in May of each year.
- Sec. 3. The start of the fiscal year of the Section shall be July 1.
- Sec. 4. At least fifteen voting members shall be present to constitute a quorum at all meetings of the Section called for the transaction of regular business and requiring a vote to be taken.
- Sec. 5. Meetings of the Section Executive Committee shall be held at such times as shall be found necessary. Section Executive meetings may be called by the Chairman of the Section at his own discretion or shall be at the request of three members of the committee.
- Sec. 6. A majority of the members of the Section Executive Committee shall constitute a quorum at all meetings of the Section Executive Committee. A quorum is necessary to conduct business.
- Sec. 7. A majority vote of the Section Executive Committee members present shall be necessary in the conduct of its business unless otherwise prescribed in these Bylaws.
- Sec. 8. The Public Relations Chairman shall send out notices of all Section Meetings to all Section members, including members of Subsections and members of Group or Society Chapters established within the Section. These notices shall contain a full statement of the time, place, and business of the meeting and shall provide, when appropriate, a pre-addressed franked card for reply. The notices shall be mailed at least ten days prior to the date of the meeting.
- Sec. 9. Meetings shall be conducted in accordance with a standard parliamentary authority.

### ARTICLE IX ---- IEEE Group or Society Chapters

- Sec. 1. A chapter of an IEEE Group or Society may be promoted by the Section, or by an IEEE Group or Society or by their respective members, by submitting a petition signed by twelve or more members above student grade of the Section who are members of the IEEE Group or Society concerned. The chapter shall be deemed established after approval of the petition by the Executive Committee of the Section, the President of that IEEE Group or Society, and the Regional Director.
- Sec. 2. All technical meetings sponsored by a chapter shall be open to all Section members and to all Affiliates of the chapter. No chapter shall hold such a meeting nor arrange a time and location for that meeting without approval by the Section Chairman or by a responsible committee of the Section. Notices of technical meetings promoted by a chapter shall be sent to members and Affiliates of the chapter.

A chapter shall assist its associated IEEE Group or Society in promoting an IEEE authorized symposium, regional meeting, etc., in the area of a Section. The chapter shall be responsible for obtaining the approval of the Section for such meetings. The Section assumes major responsibility for all such meetings held within its territory.

- Sec. 3. A chapter may elect its own chairman and other desired officers. Those elected shall hold the grade of Fellow, Senior Member or Member.
- Sec. 4. A chapter shall administer and have authority over only such funds as are (1) given to it by the associated IEEE Group or Society through the Treasurer, or (2) earmarked for it by the Section Executive Committee.

ARTICLE X —— Amendments

- Sec. 1. Suitable Bylaws or changes to the Bylaws may be adopted by a two-thirds vote of the voting members present at any regular Executive Committee meeting, providing that notice of the proposed Bylaws or changes has been sent to each voting member of the Executive Committee at least twenty days prior to such meeting. A copy of the adopted or amended Bylaws shall be submitted to the Regional Director for approval, with a copy filed in IEEE Headquarters.
- Sec. 2. Amendments to these Bylaws may originate by a majority vote of the Executive Committee or by petitions carrying the personal signatures of at least ten percent of the voting members of the Section. Proposed amendments shall be submitted in full, in a form to clearly indicate

the changes being proposed, to each voting member in the notice announcing the Section meeting at which the amendments are to be voted on. If a majority of the votes of the voting members present at this meeting are affirmative, the amendment shall be delcared adopted and a true copy shall be certified by the Secretary for inclusion in the minutes of the meeting.

Sec. 3. If an amendment shall be defeated, it cannot be resubmitted for a period of one year.

ARTICLE XI ---- Subsections

- Sec. 1. Subsections shall be subject to the Bylaws of the Section and shall be under the general jurisdiction of the Section Executive Committee.
- Sec. 2. The territory and limits of the Subsections shall be subject to definition and change by the Section Executive Committee and are subject to approval by the Regional Activities Board.
- Sec. 3. The Subsection shall have at least three elective officers, a Chairman, a Vice Chairman, and a Secretary-Treasurer.
- Sec. 4. Any vacancy occurring in the offices of the Subsection shall be filled by appointment; such appointment to be made by the Executive Committee of the Section after consultation with members of the Subsection.
- Sec. 5. All committee chairman shall be appointed by the Subsection Chairman.
- Sec. 6. Finances of the Subsection shall be operated on an annual budget approved by the Section Executive Committee. Expenditures from the Subsection funds shall not exceed this annual budget without prior approval of the Section Executive Committee.
- Sec. 7. The nomination and election of officers of the Subsection shall follow, insofar as possible, the procedure outlined for Section officers in Article VII.
- Sec. 8. The Subsection shall hold not less than five regular meetings during the year.

ARTICLE XII ---- Section Dissolution

Sec. 1. Should the Atlanta Section be dissolved for any reason whatever, all the assets, of whatever nature, shall revert to the IEEE.
