Dear Mr. Arnold:

I have the honor and the pleasure of notifying you that you have been elected an Honorary Member of the Institute, in accordance with the provision of the Constitution that Honorary Members may be elected, by the unanimous vote of all the members of the Board of Directors, "from among those who have rendered acknowledged eminent service to electrical engineering or its allied sciences".

This election will be recorded as of January 26, 1937, the date of the last meeting of the Board of Directors, the members not present having communicated their favorable votes by mail.

There are ten other Honorary Members of the Institute at the present time, namely, Andre E. Blondel, of France; Guglielmo Marconi, of England; Motoji Shibusawa, of Japan; and William LeRoy Eamet, Herbert Hoover, Arthur E. Kennelly, Robert A. Millikan, Charles F. Scott, Ambrose Swasey, and Elihu Thomson.

We propose to make the first public announcement of your election at the annual business meeting of the Institute which will be held in Milwaukee on Monday morning, June 21, the first day of the Summer Convention, and to present the certificate of Honorary Membership at that time if you can be present.
