Dear Mr. Cordes:

We are in receipt of your letter of November 13, which arrived on November 15, regarding the possibility of forming an Institute Section in Milwaukee. We have been making an effort to keep all correspondence up to date and regret to find that your letter was not answered.

The first step in the forming of a Section is the submission of a petition with signatures of members, as indicated in Bylaws Section 38, given in the attached Constitution and quoted below:

"Sec. 38--A petition for the formation of a Section shall be signed by not fewer than twenty-five (25) Fellows, Senior Members, Members, and Associates with mailing addresses within the proposed territorial limits."

Your attention is also called to Bylaws Sections 39 to 45 inclusive, which relate to Sections in general.

The area that is proposed for the Section should also be included in the petition. When a petition is received for a new Section that includes part of the area of a previously established Section, the members in such area would have to be circularized for their preference in the matter and, on the basis of the resulting votes, our Board of Directors would specify the areas of the Sections involved.

The rebate for Section meetings is \$10.00 per meeting for a maximum of 10 meetings a year. The rebate for members is \$0.75 each for up to 700 members and \$0.90 for over 700.

We look forward to hearing from you further in this matter.

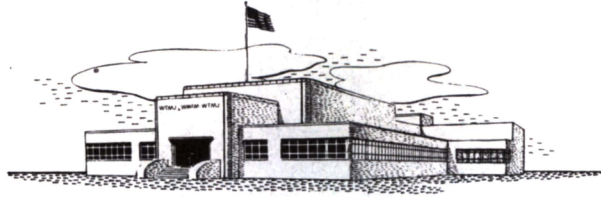

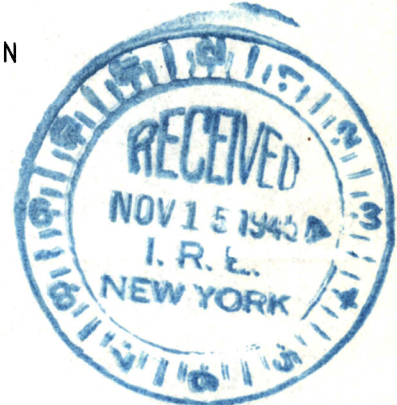

Memorandum of Agreement of Affiliation between the Engineers' Society of Milwaukee, hereinafter called the Society, and the Institute of Radio Engineers, hereinafter called the Affiliate, entered into this ____ day of _____, 194__.

1. The Affiliate agrees that at the time of its affiliation at least ten per cent (10%) of its members* having residence or regular employment within 20 miles of Milwaukee shall be Members of the Society and after a two-year period of affiliation this percentage value shall be maintained at not less than twenty-five per cent (25%).

2. The Society agrees within practical limitations to provide the Affiliate a meeting room once each month for its regular meeting at the Engineers' Society Building free of any rental or regular service charge. In general the facilities of the Building will be available to members of the Affiliate each month on the evening of its regular meeting.

3. Facilities of the Engineers' Society Building may be provided the Affiliate for more than one night a month for study classes, discussion groups, conferences, committee meetings, etc., in accordance with rules to be established by the Board of Directors of the Society.

4. The Society agrees to provide to the Affiliate the following general services free of charge, but this is subject to adjustment annually, wherever analysis shows that actual direct costs of such service exceed the amount paid to the Society by the Affiliate under the provisions of paragraph numbered six (6) below:

(a) Printing and mailing of general meeting notices of Affiliate once each month excluding July and August.

(b) Mailing of Milwaukee Engineering to each member of the Affiliate each month of publication.

*Members of Affiliates who are not technical people, and who (by agreement between the Affiliate and the Society) are not eligible for Society membership, shall not be counted in applying the percentages in this article.

(c) Miscellaneous office services such as mailing notices or circulars, general typing, mimeographing, etc., within the physical capabilities of the office personnel as regularly maintained by the Society. The Affiliate is to provide its own stationery and pay postage and other direct costs (except regular monthly notice expense) which the Society incurs in its behalf.

(d) An addressograph file of the Affiliate membership list is to be kept up to date with revisions provided by the Affiliate.

(e) The Affiliate will be provided appropriate space in Milwaukee Engineering for announcement of its meetings and general news items.

5. It is mutually agreed that members of the Society are privileged to attend all regular technical meetings of the Affiliate held in the Engineers' Society Building and likewise all members of the Affiliate are privileged to attend all regular technical meetings of the Society held in the Engineers' Society Building. However, Affiliate members are not by right of affiliate relationship with the Society entitled to attend meetings of other organizations affiliated with the Society.

6. The Affiliate agrees to contribute annually to the operating fund of the Society in support of its general program as follows:

For the first 100 members of Affiliate or
fraction thereof -- - - - - \$1.50 each

For all Affiliate members over 100 - - - - - 1.00 each

(a) If the Affiliate is a local section or chapter of a national organization and receives the principal portion of its operating funds from such national organization, the above contribution to the Society shall not be payable until the Affiliate has received its payment from said national organization.

7. Once each year at a time established by the Affiliate, such Affiliate shall furnish the Society a list or roster of its members who are to receive general notices of its meetings and Milwaukee Engineering. This list shall be used as the basis for determining

the annual contribution of the Affiliate as set forth in paragraph numbered six (6) above, except that the Affiliate shall be permitted to add, and so designate, certain non-members' names to the mailing list (such as exchanges, national society officers, etc.) up to a maximum of 5% of the membership of the Affiliate without additional contribution.

8. The Society agrees to make a refund to the Affiliate for each of its members, who are likewise Members of the Society, on the basis of one dollar (\$1.00) per year for each such member, such refund to be made within sixty (60) days of the receipt of contributions set forth in paragraph numbered six (6) above.

9. (a) There shall be a Council composed of the President and Secretary of the Society and the presiding officer and secretary of the Affiliate (or alternates appointed by them) and of each of the other affiliated organizations.

(b) The Council shall have no jurisdiction over the meetings or actions of the constituent organizations individually or jointly except as authorized by such organizations. Essentially, its duties shall be advisory.

(c) The President and Secretary of the Society shall be the chairman and secretary respectively of the Council.

(d) The Council and the Board of Directors of the Society may meet concurrently but in such cases the actions of the two bodies shall be kept in separate minutes.

10. This agreement shall continue in force until _____ but can be terminated after one year by either party on sixty (60) days notice.

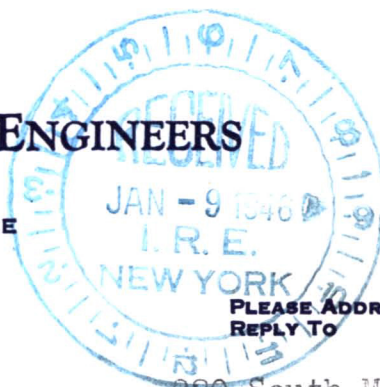

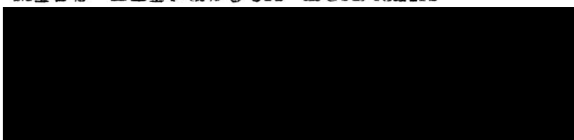

AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE ENGINEERS' SOCIETY OF MILWAUKEE
and the
MILWAUKEE SECTION OF THE A. I. E. E.

The Engineers' Society of Milwaukee proposes to allow the Milwaukee section of the A.I.E.E. the unrestricted use of its permanent rooms as headquarters: also, the use of its lecture room for the public meetings at least twice a year: also, to provide a stenographer who shall be available at certain stated times to assist the officers in the work of the Section and to prepare and mail notices of general Comm. meetings, etc: also, to supply all printed notices, etc. and postage for same: also, to send to all members of the Milwaukee Section notices and invitations to all public meetings of the Engineers' Society or any other Societies which may be associated with it.

In consideration of the above, the Milwaukee Section shall arrange to sent notices and invitations to its public meetings to -all the members of the Engineers' Society and any other Societies associated with it: shall arrange that a member of the Programme Comm. of the Engineers' Society shall be ex.officio member of its Programme Comm. (this provision will acquaint the Engineers' Society Comm. with the plans of each allied Society and allow suitable arrangement of dates), and shall pay to the Engineers' Society an annual fee of Three Dollars (\$3.00) per member: this to be due and payable in advance in equal installments on December 1st, and June 1st of each year and be based on the membership of record, on the directly preceding Nov. 1st and May 1st, respectively.

This proposition when signed by the President of the Engineers' Society of Milwaukee and the Chairman of the Milwaukee Section A.I.E.E. to be a binding contract for one year from date hereof.
