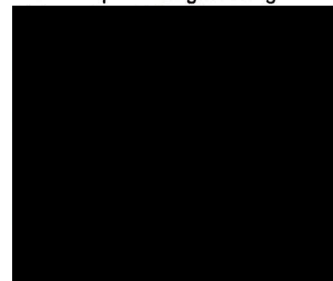
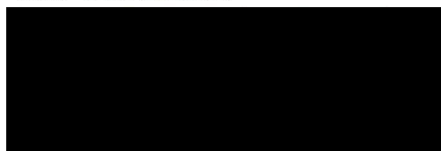

The addition of the proposed subparagraph f is intended to remove any ambiguities relative to the university foundation adding excess funds to the endowment principal.

PROPOSED ACTION: The Regional Activities Board to recommend to the Executive Committee adoption of the proposed Addendum to the Piedmont Section IEEE Endowment Award in accordance with IEEE Bylaws.

The Piedmont Section of I.E.E.E. has made a contribution of \$2,500 to establish an endowed award. The award, the Piedmont Section of I.E.E.E. Award, is established in the Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering.

The Clemson University Foundation agrees to accept the endowment principal and to invest and reinvest the endowment and to transmit annually the investment income to Clemson University to fulfill the purposes of this agreement.

Clemson University agrees to accept the annual investment income and to administer the award in accordance with the provisions described below:

- a. Initially, an award of \$100 and a certificate shall be given to an outstanding junior, who exhibits the potential for success in the field of electrical engineering based on scholarship and leadership.
- b. The recipient will be recommended by the Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering Scholarships and Awards Committee and the current awards selection policies and procedures shall be followed.
- c. The value of the award and/or the number of awards will be determined by the University Scholarships and Awards Committee, based upon recommendations from the Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering Scholarships and Awards Committee and sufficient investment income. The recommendations from the Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering Scholarships and Awards Committee must be approved by the Executive Committee of the Piedmont Section of I.E.E.E.
- d. The first award of \$100 will be subtracted from the \$2,500 contribution and will be made on Honors and Awards Day in April 1980. Thereafter, the awards will be made from the investment income only.







ADDENDUM TO TRIPARTITE AGREEMENT  
AMONG  
THE PIEDMONT SECTION OF I.E.E.E.

CLEMSON UNIVERSITY  
FOR THE PIEDMONT SECTION I.E.E.E. AWARD

The purpose of this Addendum is two-fold. First, to clarify the ambiguities in subparagraphs c. and d. of the Tripartite Agreement executed in March of 1980, by adding subparagraph f. set forth below. The second purpose of this Addendum is to clarify the meaning of the last paragraph of the March Agreement in light of the addition of new subparagraph f.

Subparagraphs c. and d. indicate the initially there could be more than one award and that awards could exceed \$100. Neither of those possibilities is intended until the endowment balance reaches \$4,000. Accordingly, a new subparagraph f. is added to the Agreement as follows:

- f. The Clemson University Foundation will add to the endowment principal, investment income in excess of the \$100 required to fund the annual award. Only \$100 will be transferred to Clemson University and placed into the Piedmont Section I.E.E.E. Award Account for disbursement. Upon reaching the endowment balance of \$4,000 the intentions of paragraphs c. and d. may be exercised.


The last paragraph of the Agreement of March of 1980 shall be interpreted to mean that if the award ceases to be made. The entire annual investment income will be transmitted by the Clemson University Foundation and will be allocated by the Board of Trustees of Clemson University to aid the student chapter of I.E.E.E.







- c. The value of the award and/or the number of awards will be determined by the University Scholarships and Awards Committee, based upon recommendations from the Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering Scholarships and Awards Committee and sufficient investment income. 
Dear Dave:

Enclosed is an addendum to the Piedmont Section IEEE Award. We had originally thought the university would add excess funds to the endowment principal. The university foundation does not do this unless so stated in the agreement. Therefore, this addendum clears this point up. If agreeable with you, would you please sign all copies, keep one, and send the rest back to me.

We would like to obtain permission from the IEEE to set up a Piedmont Section Student Paper Contest award each year for \$200. The way this would work is as follows. Each January, the student branch of the IEEE at Clemson would host the regular Piedmont Section. At this meeting, the students would present papers to be judged. The winner of the student paper contest would represent Clemson at the upcoming Southeastcon. A cash award would be given to the first three or four papers judged to be the best. We would like to keep the amount of each award flexible in value since the number of papers could vary. However, the total amount of all awards would not exceed \$200.

We would like permission to present this award on a permanent basis and not have to obtain permission each year. This is because we can set up a yearly commitment with the students, and it is very possible that future section chairmen would forget to obtain permission in time for the paper award.

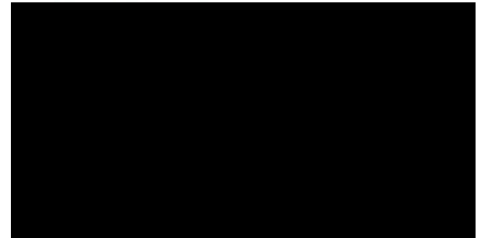

This is to request to bring to the attention of the Executive Committee, at their August meeting, the enclosed addendum to the Piedmont Sections IEEE Endowment Award; for their approval. The purpose of this addendum is to clarify ambiguities in sub-paragraphs c and d of the original Tripartite Agreement executed in March of 1980, and clarify the meaning of the last paragraph of the original agreement in light of the addition of the new sub-paragraph f.

Also, in the attached letter, the Piedmont Section is requesting permission to establish an annual Piedmont Section Student Paper Award Contest on a permanent basis, which Executive Committee approval is also requested. This request meets the conditions outlined in the January 1980 Policy and Procedures Manual, Section 10.4, as follows:

I. Paragraph (A) - 2)

The award does not exceed \$500.

II. Paragraph (D) - 2)

(a) to establish annually, an IEEE Piedmont Section Student Paper Contest Award on a permanent basis.

(b) a \$200 annually cash award would be given to the first three or four student papers judged to be the best, each January. The total of all awards would not exceed \$200. The source of the funds are tutorial, symposium and section rebate.

(c) Clemson University, College of Engineering, IEEE Student Branch Members

- (d) to further the objective of the IEEE as stated in the IEEE Constitution, Article I, Section 2. The student whose paper is judged best overall would represent Clemson University at the upcoming SOUTHEASTCON Conference.

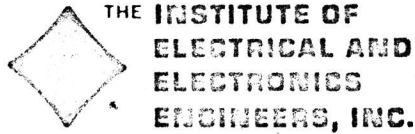

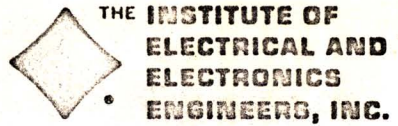

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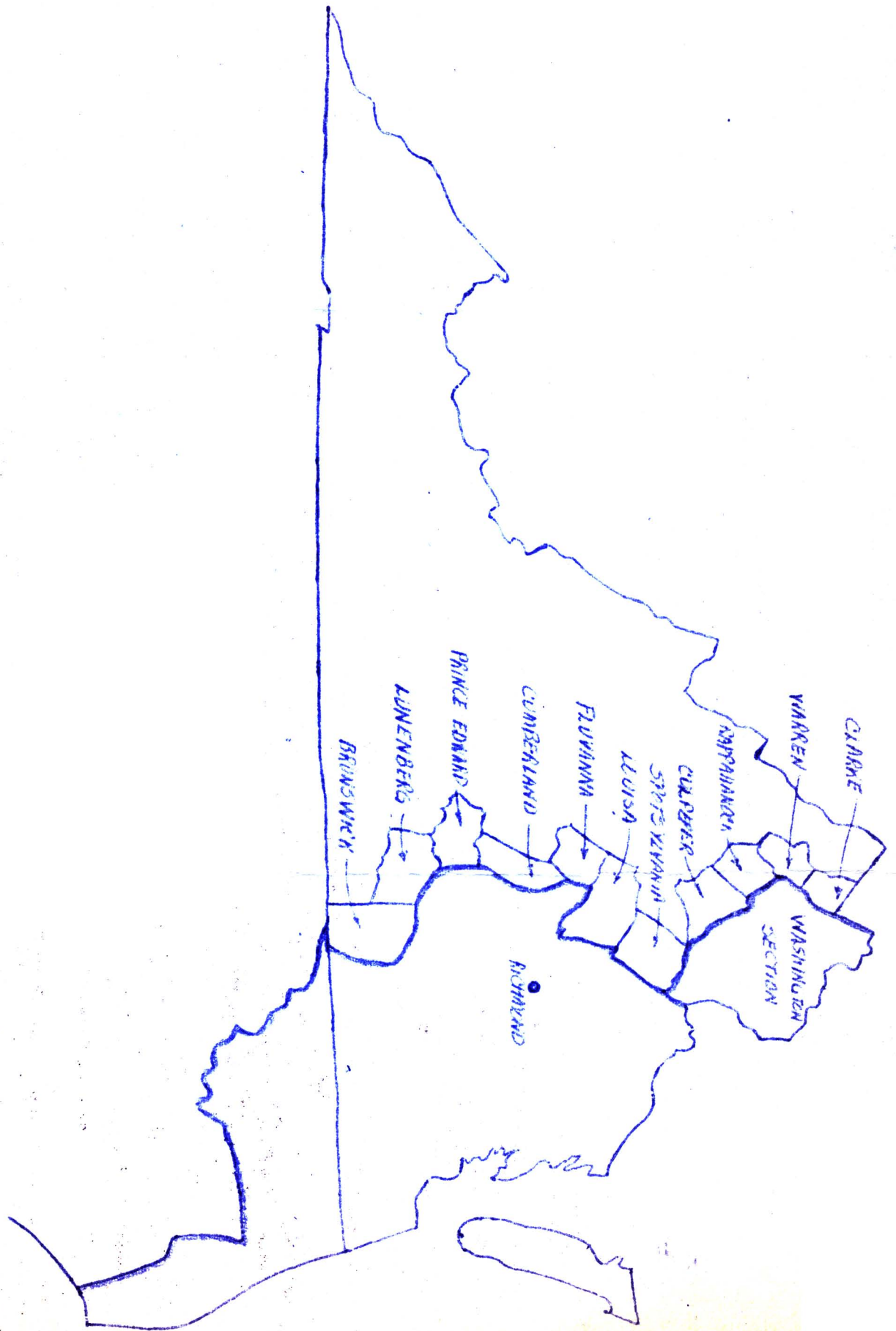
