BYLAWS OF THE DALLAS SECTION OF
THE INSTITUTE OF ELECTRICAL AND ELECTRONICS ENGINEERS

ARTICLE I - OFFICERS

Sec. 1 - The officers of the Section shall be a Chairman, an Executive Vice-Chairman, two (2) Vice-Chairmen, a Secretary, and a Treasurer.

Sec. 2 - Duly elected officers shall accept active responsibility for the Section's program and activities beginning 1 July and lasting until 1 July the following year. Even though not officially in office, incoming officers shall begin to study their duties, select necessary assistants, and plan for the coming year as soon as convenient, certainly within a month, after being officially notified of their election.

Sec. 3 - All officers shall be of Member grade or higher.

ARTICLE II - MANAGEMENT

Sec. 1 - There shall be a Section Executive Committee consisting of the officers, the Junior Past Chairman and Chairman of all standing committees listed elsewhere in these Bylaws. All Technical Groups and Professional Technical Group Chapters shall have representation on the Committee. The Chairman of each Sub-section and each member of the Regional Committee shall be ex-officio members.

Sec. 2 - The Chairman, responsible to the Section Executive Committee, shall have general supervision of the affairs of the Section. He shall preside at meetings of the Section and the Section Executive Committee and have such other powers and perform such other duties as may be provided for in the Section Bylaws, or as may be delegated to him by vote of the Section. In his absence, his duties shall be performed by the Executive Vice-Chairman.

Sec. 3 - The Executive Vice-Chairman shall be editor of Section publications such as DIRECTION and Vice-Chairman of the Publicity Committee, in addition to executive duties involved in the management of the Section's program and activities as set forth by the Executive Committee.

Sec. 4 - The Vice-Chairmen - (a) One of the Vice-Chairmen to be responsible in general for technical activities relating to the electronics field and in particular for the supervision and coordination of electronic related Group activities, the Section's Program (meetings and papers) and for Section meetings. The Vice-Chairman shall appoint, after approval of the Section Chairman, the staff necessary for performance of his duties. (b) The other Vice-Chairman will be responsible in general for the technical activities relating to the electrical field and in particular for the organization and operation of the electrical (Power) related Group activities, the arrangement of Technical Study courses, and planning and arrangement of the Section's Special Entertainment. To perform these duties, the Vice-Chairman shall appoint, after approval of the Chairman, the necessary staff.

Sec. 5 - The Treasurer shall receive and deposit all monies in the name of the Section in such depository as shall be determined by the Section Executive Committee. He shall make only such disbursements as shall be ordered by the Section Executive Committee. He shall make such reports as may be required by the Section Executive Committee.

Sec. 6 - The Secretary shall insure that notices are sent out, agenda prepared, and minutes recorded of all meetings of the Section and of the Section Executive Committee. He shall make such reports as may be required by the IEEE Bylaws.

Sec. 7 - The Section Chairman, as soon as practical after his election, shall appoint Chairmen of the following standing committees:

- Membership Committee
- Awards Committee
- Student Activities Committee

Members appointed shall serve until their successors are appointed or the Committee dissolved.

The Chairman shall also appoint a Nominating Committee of four former section officers selected to represent as nearly as possible the various interests of the section membership.

Other committees may be authorized by vote of the Section Executive Committee at any regular meeting, with the Chairman of these committees appointed by the Section Chairman.

Sec. 8 - The Chairman shall appoint a SWIEEEO Board representative, Official Observers to the Dallas Council of Scientific Societies, and other representative as approved by the Executive Committee.

ARTICLE III - NOMINATION AND ELECTION OF OFFICERS

Sec. 1 - All officers shall be elected by a majority of votes cast by letter ballot.

Sec. 2 - The Section Nominating Committee shall be appointed by the Chairman of the Section not later than 15 January and in time to be publicized in the February issue of the Section magazine DIRECTION. The nominating committee shall solicit suggestions from the voting members of the Section prior to 15 February, at which date the committee will forward a list of recommended candidates together with pertinent biographical material to the Editor of DIRECTION Magazine for publication in the March issue. The Nominating Committee will get agreement to serve from all recommended candidates. A period of twenty-eight (28) days shall be allowed after announcement of the Nominating Committee candidates to permit nominations by petitions before nominations are closed. Petitions for nomination must have twenty (20) signatures of members eligible to vote. Ballots listing the nominations of the Nominating Committee, any nominations by petition, and including space for write-in candidates, will be mailed to all members of the Section eligible to vote by 1 April, or thirty (30) days after the mailing date of the March issue of DIRECTION, whichever is later. Returned, signed ballots must be postmarked within fifteen days of the ballot mailing date to be counted in the election.

- A Tellers Committee appointed by the Section's Executive Committee shall count the vote and determine the successful candidates.

The Chairman shall inform the successful candidates immediately in order that the incoming officers can observe the appropriate Business meetings usually conducted at the Southwestern IEEE Conference and that incoming officers can begin planning for the next year's program and activities for the Section.

Sec. 3 - Vacancies in offices shall be filled by the Section Executive Committee for the remainder of the unexpired term, unless otherwise provided for.

ARTICLE IV - MEETINGS

Sec. 1 - Regular Section meetings shall be held each month from September through June of each year with appropriate exceptions as arranged by the Executive Committee for the month of December. Dates for regular Section meetings shall be the second Tuesday, unless changed by the Executive Committee.

Sec. 2 - At least 30 members shall be present to constitute a quorum at all meetings of the Section called for the transaction of regular business and requiring a vote to be taken.

Sec. 3 - Meetings of the Section Executive Committee shall be held in or prior to August, during January and at such other times as shall be found necessary. Section Executive Committee meetings may be called by the Chairman of the Section at his own discretion or at the request of three members of the committee.

Sec. 4 - A majority of the members of the Section Executive Committee shall constitute a quorum at all meetings of the Section Executive Committee.

Sec. 5 - A majority vote of the Section Executive Committee shall be necessary in the conduct of its business except as otherwise provided in the Section Constitution or Bylaws.

Sec. 6 - The Secretary shall send out notices of all regular Section meetings to all IEEE members in the territory of the Section at least one week prior to the date of the meeting. These notices shall contain a full statement of the time, place and business of the meeting. Placing a notice in DIRECTION magazine is a satisfactory and preferable means for "sending out notices".

Sec. 7 - Meetings shall be conducted in accordance with Robert's Rules of Order Revised.

ARTICLE V - SUBSECTION

Sec. 1 - Subsections of the Dallas Section may be established in accordance with provisions as set forth in the IEEE Constitution and Bylaws from IEEE members residing outside the Metropolitan Area of Dallas and outside any previously organized Dallas subsection but within the geographic area assigned to the Dallas Section.

Sec. 2 - The Dallas Section will refer to the IEEE Constitution and Bylaws and the Dallas Section Bylaws for guidance in all the various Section-Subsection relations.

Sec. 3 - As a matter of policy, the Dallas Section and any of its Subsections will seek out cooperative programs of mutual advantage.

ARTICLE VI - SECTION PUBLICATION

Sec. 1 - The Dallas Section authorizes the publication of Direction. The purpose of this publication is to advise Section members of Section activities, provide articles of interest and to promote the general aims of the Section as set forth in the Section Constitution, Article I, Section 2.

Sec. 2 - Editing and publishing shall be the direct responsibility of the Executive Vice-Chairman under general supervision by the Executive Committee. The Executive Committee is expected to monitor DIRECTION closely and provide statements of policy where needed.

Sec. 3 - DIRECTION shall be published on a monthly basis from September through June of each year. As a general rule, mailing should be on the first of the month.

Sec. 4 - DIRECTION shall be financed by the inclusion of advertising. The rates for such advertising shall be set by the Executive Committee, with the advice of the Executive Vice-Chairman and the Publication Manager. Total advertising space in any one issue should not exceed the space allotted to editorial copy. Any profits which may accrue from the publication of DIRECTION shall be placed in the Section Treasury and may be used to defray expenses of the Section as authorized by the Executive Committee.

Sec. 5 - Publications Manager is to be selected by the Executive Vice-Chairman subject to approval by the Executive Committee.

Sec. 6 - The Section magazine, DIRECTION, shall be mailed to all Section members with their annual subscription rate of 50 cents being paid from the member allowance. Subscription rates for members of other sections or for non-members of the Institute may be established by the Executive Committee.

ARTICLE VII - AMENDMENTS

Sec. 1 - Proposed amendments to these Bylaws shall be submitted to the IEEE Executive Committee, and shall become effective upon approval by the IEEE Executive Committee.

Sec. 2 - Amendments to these Bylaws may be proposed either by the Section Executive Committee or by a petition signed by 20 Section Members submitted to the Executive Committee. Amendments may be adopted by a two-thirds vote of the voting members present at any regular meeting, providing that notice of the proposed change has been sent to each voting member at least three weeks prior to such meeting. Voting by ballot is permissible provided the same conditions exist as for voting at a regular meeting. Such Bylaws must be consonant with the IEEE Constitution and Bylaws and the Section Constitution. A copy of these Bylaws shall be filed in the IEEE Headquarters.
