Dear Ben:

On February 28, 1950, the Executive Committee approved the formation of a Miami Section of the Institute, subject to receipt of notification stating that the Section will conform to the Constitution for Sections approved by the Board of Directors.

Mr. A. W. Shropshire, of Radio Station WGBS, 1605 Biscayne Boulevard, Miami 36, Florida, Acting Chairman of the committee which initiated action on the formation of this Section, was notified of this action.

As Director of Region 6, we are calling your attention to the fact that Headquarters has not received from the Miami Section notification stating that they will conform to the Constitution for Sections, nor have we had any response to three letters addressed to Mr. Shropshire under dates of June 22, July 19 and September 12, 1950, requesting information, including the names of the officers of this Section. Mr. Shropshire has also been informed that, pending receipt of the required notification and slate of officers, two quarterly rebates, to which this Section is entitled, are being held at Headquarters.

We are puzzled by this inactivity and would very much appreciate your investigating the matter and advising us whether or not the Miami Section intends to fulfill the requirements for the formation of an IRE Section. 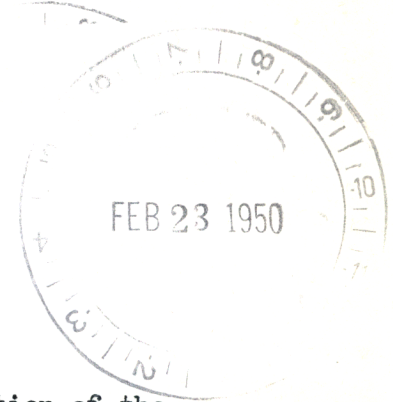

Dear Mr. Bailey:

On February 7th of this year a meeting of the Atlanta section of the I.R.E. was held in Miami. The primary purpose of the meeting was to endeavor to organize a Miami section of the Institute. Presiding at the meeting was Mr. Henry I. Metz, former chairman of the Atlanta section.

Mr. Metz appointed me temporary chairman of a committee that is to attempt the organization of the proposed Miami section.

The meeting was held at the University of Miami. One hundred and six people were present. Lapel cards were passed out at the door and ninety-three of these cards were returned at the conclusion of the meeting. An analysis of the cards shows the following attendance:

Senior members	3
Members	4
Associates	22
Students	9
Guests	55

Forty-eight of the guests have indicated a desire to become members and nine of the members have indicated that they would like to apply for higher grades.

The enclosed petition was circulated at the meeting and bears thirty-nine signatures. Eight of the signatures are of student members although they were asked not to sign the petition.

Will you please place the petition in the proper channels to have it acted upon by the Board of Directors as soon as possible.

It is believed that the Miami area will be capable of supporting a section. The distance to Atlanta is such that few members in this area ever have an opportunity to attend the Atlanta meetings. The present estimated population of the Miami area is 500,000. There is an unusual amount of radio activity in the area. The airlines and the CAA have large installations here in addition to the activity at the University of Miami. There are also the other activities that usually exist in most areas of equivalent population.

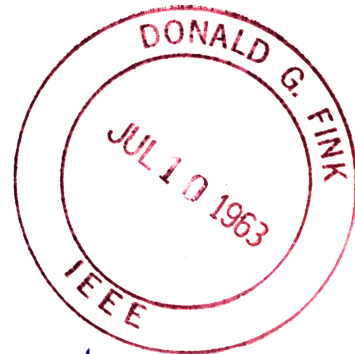


This section will include the Florida counties of Broward, Collier, Dade, and Monroe.

5. Unless otherwise advised the following local bylaws will be in effect upon implementation of the MIAMI Section IEEE

a. Fiscal Year - of the Section is established to run 1 July thru 30 June of the following year.

b. Annual Meeting - will be in June of each year.

c. Number of Meetings - a minimum of ten (10) monthly meetings will be held annually.

d. Election - will be conducted in accordance with the constitution set forth in the IEEE Sections Manual. Election to section offices below Chairman does not establish by implication or otherwise any pre-emptive rights of progression thru the offices. (eg. Secretary become Vice-Chairman at next election, etc.)

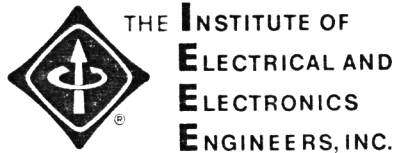
