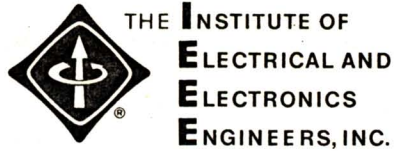
Dave,

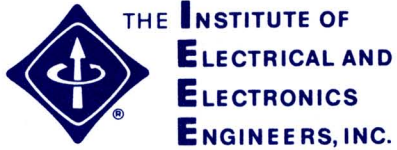

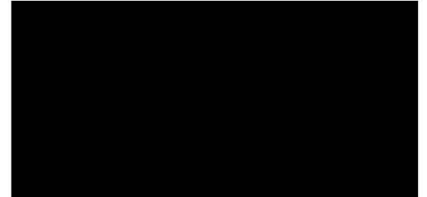

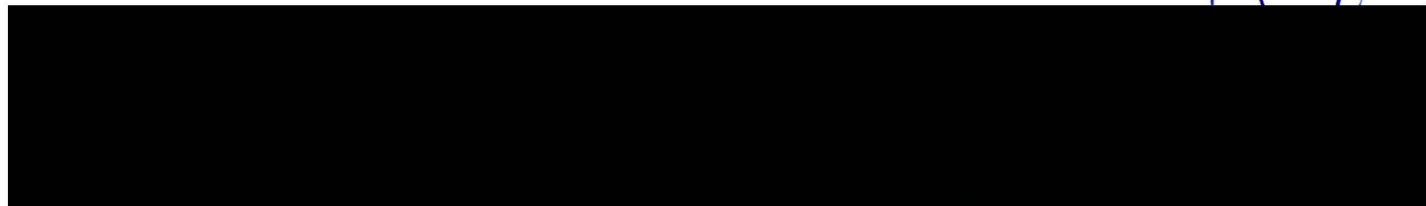
