

SECTION STATUS FOR VICTORIA - PETITION

FOLLOWING SUPPORT FROM THE AUSTRALIAN SECTION COMMITTEE FOR THE CHANGE, YOUR SUB-SECTION COMMITTEE HAS VOTED TO SEEK THE SUPPORT OF ALL MEMBERS IN VICTORIA FOR A PETITION TO UPGRADE VICTORIA TO FULL IEEE SECTION STATUS. A MESSAGE FROM YOUR CHAIRMAN FOLLOWS.

Dear Member,

As you are aware, for the last two years the IEEE has been represented in Victoria by the Victorian Sub-Section. The Sub-Section is, in turn, attached to the Australian Section located in Sydney. The Australian Section committee has the responsibility for the financial operations of the Sub-Section which includes the preparation and distribution of CIRCUIT and any other information mailed to members. This arrangement has meant that there have been some unavoidable delays in communications between the Sub-Section Committee and members in Victoria.

The Australian Section and the Victorian Sub-Section committees both agree that it would be highly desirable to form a Victorian Section. The formation of Sections in other Australian States is also being considered by the Australian Section and the Region 10 Director, Professor Harry Green.

Under Section arrangements the Victorian membership would enjoy (1) An increased IEEE rebate funding of approximately 20% per annum, and (2) An improved responsiveness in services and communications at the local level.

The IEEE rules require a Section to be formed by a petition of not fewer than 50 members, other than students and associates. These members must have mailing addresses within the territorial limits proposed in the petition, in this case within the State of Victoria. There are currently over 500 IEEE members in Victoria.

For this reason please find attached a form for you to sign this petition. If you agree would you fill out the form and forward to the above address by August 1, 1983.

My committee and I commend this action to you.
