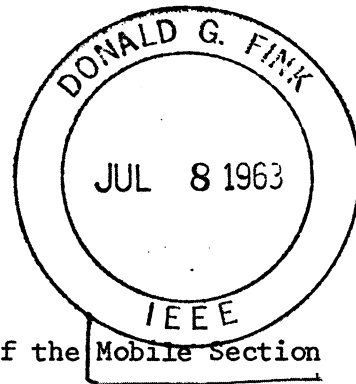



THRU: Director Region III IEEE

1. We, the representatives of the Mobile Section IRE and portion of the Gulf Coast Section AIEE, do hereby jointly petition for recognition of the merged activities into the MOBILE SECTION IEEE, effective 1 July 1963.

2. Territory of the Mobile Section IEEE to include the following counties in the states of:

ALABAMA - Clarke, Baldwin, Washington, Mobile

MISSISSIPPI - George, Jackson
(Refer Map attachment 1)

Written approval of the territory setforth above, obtained from adjoining activities, is submitted as attachment 2.

3. Membership of the Mobile Section IEEE, approximately 130, exceeds the established minimum requirements, and can be authenticated by records of Headquarters IEEE.

4. The Mobile Section IEEE will abide by the Constitution for Sections approved by the Board of Directors IEEE.

5. Unless otherwise advised the following local bylaws will be effected upon implementation of the Mobile Section IEEE 1 July 1963.

a. Fiscal Year - of the Section is established to run 1 July thru 30 June of the following year.

b. Annual Meeting - will be in June of each year.

c. Number of Meetings - a minimum of ten (10) monthly meetings will be scheduled annually.

d. Election - will be conducted in accordance with the constitution as setforth in the IEEE section's manual. Election to section offices below Chairman does not establish by implication or otherwise any pre-emptive rights of progression thru the offices. (e.g. Secretary become Vice - Chairman at next election etc.)
