

Subj: Petition to Dissolve the Michiana Section

The Michiana Section has been inactive for some 7 years. It has failed to provide IEEE Regional Activities with the required New Officers Report, the Meetings Report and the Financial Report per Section 5.4.M of the RAB Operations Manual.

Several attempts have been made to reactivate the Section, but to no avail. I have made several contacts with past officers to attempt to form a core team to reactivate the Section. The Region 4 East Area Chair Don Bramlett has made recent contacts. And, our West Michigan Section leadership has been active in the area. We detect no Section operation and have found no one willing to take on the task of reactivation.

Don Bramlett is in contact with the Sections involved and has found support for the action as recommended below. He does note that in his contact with the Michiana Section "past Treasurer" Michael Stoll, there is a report of some Section financial support of a Student Branch. I have informed Don of the seriousness of this situation. RAB is aware of the status and Don is pursuing the matter with the direction to secure the funds as IEEE funds and to pursue long term support for the Student Branch.

I, therefore, petition RAB to invoke 5.4.N of the IEEE RAB Operations Manual and automatically dissolve the Michiana Section and reassign its members and territory within the boundaries of Michigan to the West Michigan Section and within the boundaries of Indiana to the Calumet Section.

As soon as RAB approves this petition, The West Michigan Section and the Calumet Section will revise their respective bylaws and begin serving our members in these areas. With the securing of the funds of the Michiana Section satisfactory to IEEE, Region 4 is prepared to divide the remaining funds between the receiving Sections in proportion to their respective gains in membership.

We had an open discussion on the floor regarding your proposal, re- Sub-Section of Detroit and after much debate it was decided to continue with the petition for a separate section. The general consensus was that regardless of the eventual organization structure for Grand Rapids, the members could not see where the Detroit section would be of much help. The distance of (150 miles) and the communication lag would make any operation a problem. Past experience has indicated that we can communicate faster with New York than we can Detroit.

Perhaps you may not be aware of the membership here but we have attending our meetings, past residents of Detroit and area as well as past Chairman. This type of representation gives our discussions the balance which normally would not be present if the members were all from Western Michigan. Thank you for your letters of November 13 and 26 reporting your activities in connection with the move to organize a Western Michigan IRE Section. Your progress to date sounds very encouraging.

The Detroit Section has long been aware of the widespread geographic distribution of its members. At the present time, the Section boundaries include all of the southern peninsula of Michigan except for the extreme southwest corner. The attached sketch, based on the 1958 Directory, shows the territory and the location of IRE members. As you can see, major concentrations of members exist at Detroit, Ann Arbor, Grand Rapids, Lansing, Jackson, and Flint. The remaining membership is scattered pretty well over the entire area. It was assumed, incidentally, that you intended to include Leelanau County rather than Lenawee as indicated in your letter.

Such distribution has always limited what the Detroit Section could do for its out-lying members. We do make conscious efforts to improve in this direction -- for example, we are now regularly holding one meeting a year in Ann Arbor and one in Lansing. However, we recognize that this leaves much to be desired from your point of view and readily sympathize with your desire to form a separate section.

This subject was discussed at our Executive Committee meeting of November 25 in the light of your first letter. As indicated above, the general feeling is one of sympathy with your move. At the same time, there is some concern that sufficient potential membership exists in the proposed area to support an active section. Our concern stems partially from having witnessed at first hand the failure of two local professional groups. Both were organized with a great deal of enthusiasm on an apparently sound basis only to collapse in two or three years from lack of interest.

Your situation, of course, is quite different, and we do not mean to imply that your fate would be similar to that of the two professional group chapters. However, the maintenance of strong interest and enthusiasm is sometimes a difficult thing in organizations such as our own. In view of this, we would suggest for your consideration that the activity be organized initially as a sub-section of the Detroit Section. This approach would provide the opportunity to test better the long-term interests of your membership without involving the formality of setting up a full section. In many respects, however, you would operate as a section, having your own meetings and officers.


We would be interested in your thoughts on this possibility. In the meantime, we intend to study the situation further. Our last Executive Committee meeting coincided with the meeting of November 25 to which you had invited us, but we will try to attend your next meeting on December 10. Likewise, we invite you and your associates to attend our next meeting to be held at 8:00 PM on December 13 at the Engineering Society of Detroit. There will be an informal dinner at 6:30 if you are able to get here that early.
