### Sub: Upgrading of KKharagpur Sub-Section

This has reference to the correspondence resting with your letter of 2nd May 1985, addressed to Prof.M.N.Roy, Chairman of Calcutta Section.

During my sojourn at New York on the 20th May 85, I called on Mr. Don Suppers and discussed with him the proposal to elevate Kharagpur Sub-Section to Section status. Subsequently, when I spoke to Mr. Don Suppers from New Orleans, he desired that I should try and speak to you, but unfortunately I could not get through, you during the short time at my disposal.

Some of the points we should consider are whether in the same State of West Bengal, we should have two Sections. Kharagpur is in West Bengal and the territory proposed by them includes a portion of West Bengal, the whole of Orissa and a portion of the Bihar State - which regions are presently with Calcutta Section. In other words, by upgrading the Kharagpur Sub-Section we would be weakening the Calcutta Section. Further, the Membership presently at Calcutta Section and Kharagpur Sub-Section, are not in my opinion, sufficient for two Sections to operate in that part of the country.

I understand that your goodself would be attending Region 10 Meeting at Bangkok by end of July 85 and we should take the opportunity to discuss this matter threadbare as Prof. M. N. Roy and Mr. Eric Hertz would also be present at Bangkok.

- 3. I would like to mention further that, in India, there are seven sections at the moment, but no single state has two sections. Kharagpur is not only in the same state (West Bengal) as Calcutta but also situated in close proximity (116 Km) with Calcutta Section. Hence we would suggest that definite demarcation of geographical area of the Kharagpur Section be done by joint consultation. Otherwise, the formation of more such sections in eastern region may dissolve Calcutta Section in future.

The Kharagpur Subsection of the IEEE has mushrooned impressively. Starting with a total strength of 22 members, it now has more than 50 members with the bulk of the membership in the city of Kharagpur. There are an additional 75 odd student members of IEEE and the IIT Kharagpur IEEE Student Branch.

The Subsection and the Student Branch are not only large, they are also active. Thus in the last quarter of 81, we arranged 3 technical talks; in 82 we arranged 11 technical talks and 2 technical visits; in 83 we arranged 15 technical talks and 2 technical visits. These talks have been at advanced levels and ranged over a wide range of topics starting from personal Computers to Remote Sensing Over and above these, we at Kharagpur have arranged 4 paper contest and 4 courses over the last two years. Most of the paper contests and all the courses have been well received with participation well beyond expectation.

Even all these activities do not fully depict the potential at Kharagpur. At Kharagpur we have the INDIAN INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY which is a premier institute in India, and is internationally renowned. This institute has a faculty of 500 odd and about 3000 students distributed over some 25 Departments and Centres. eight Departments and Centres in IEEE related fields. To tap this potential it is desirable that the Kharagpur Subsection be upgraded to a Section. This will lead to an enhancement of the subsection's activities and member enrollment. We will also be able to open several society chapters at Kharagpur. This is all the more important because Kharagpur is quite an isolated place. example, Kharagpur is quite far from Calcutta - two a half hours train journey- and hence


