Next week I am visiting New Delhi where I hope to arrange something similar. And finally I shall turn my attention to my own area, Calcutta.

Unfortunately, although I found interest and even enthusiasm I do not hold out high hopes for the Indian section. Now that I have had the opportunity of meeting the members I find that their interests and professional levels may not lead to their gaining much from such a venture. In particular I find that many of them maintain membership for prestige reasons - the initials M.I.R.E. after their names on their stationery. On the other hand, the type that are most interested in our publications are too poor to afford membership. The salary for a research worker after 5 to 10 years is only of the order of 600 Rupees a month - about\$120! I understand that the Madras

members of the Institution of Electrical Engineers have given up their common meetings years ago as they couldn't bring them together even once a year. However the people who have agreed to serve as provisional secretaries are interested and devoted and perhaps something can be done.

I don't know what forms it may take, but if the IRE could be of as/sistance to India through the section that might have an excellent effect. I'll be able to tell youmore on this after my visit to New Delhi where I'm meeting the Presdient of the ITE - Institution of Telecommunication Engineers (India).



It is quite a long time since I have last corresponded with you, George, however an occurrence of the past several days has prompted me to drop a letter to an old friend of AFCEA days, for some enlightenment.

Several days ago I received a note from a Mr. Morton Nadler who is with the Indian Statistical Institute, Calcutta, to the effect that he would visit Bombay, with a view to establishing an IRE Section. I was very happy to meet him yesterday as he is my first personal contact with IRE since arriving in India in Feb.1958.

I am rather intrigued with the sudden idea of the possibility of forming an India IRE Section and also quite surprised to learn of so many Indian members. In the absence of Conventions, Conferences, Meetings etc. as well as the absence of Industry except the assembly of foreign made parts, I would be quite interested to know what sort of a "rallying point", we would have. Now, Mr. Nadler is fresh out of a ten year stretch in Czechoslovakia and it just occurs to me that it might be very helpful if you should approach some prominent Indians, who are in a dominant position, to more effectively promote such an IRE Section in India, in case it is your desire, to actively promote such activities. I would be happy to assist your effort in this respect if required. The usual method of working here on the part of U.N. and also ICA (USA) people is to advise and to assist the Indians to carry out the many projects, with the Indians holding the executive position. This may be the slower approach as I find in my own work, however it is the most acceptable method.

I should be interested in hearing from you, to learn all about the big strides in IRE and AFCEA. I see that two of our good friends have become Generals, namely, Watts and Heinrich. It is good to see that the deserving are being recognised.

Dear Miss Sirjane:

Thank you for the sample constitution and mailing line. Now that monsoon is drawing to a close I am going to make a lecture tour of the main centers of Indian electronics, at which I shall also raise the question of the Indian IRE section. The preliminary response is very encouraging. Prof. Sreenivasan of Bangalore writes that there are at present several thousand scientists and engineers who can come within the scope of the IRE in the different grades of membership.

He also suggests that any such venture should cooperate with the Institution of Telecommunication Engineers of India, with whom I have established contact and will see near the end of September. Here in India, aside from the just-named organisation, many are members of the Institution of Electrical Engineers of England. The fact is that many Indian engineers cannot afford membership in more than one organisation, particularly those in government positions (the situation in private industry is somewhat better). My own assistant here who is a member of the IEE earns only Rs 400 a month (about \$801). So IRE dues for him would come to almost a week's salary, even without professional groups.

One proprietor of a firm asked me for help in finding personnel. He would pay "Rs 2000 for a foreigner (European or American), 800 for an Indian. And this, without regard to qualifications. So you see the problem we are up against if we want to expand IRE membership here. However, there are certainly enough to free form a section. In view of the great aize of this country, however, it will be difficult to hold "section" meetings more than once a year. I therefore propose to start immediately with sub-sections as well, to wit 1. Delhi, 2. Bombay, 3. Bangalore-Madras, 4. Calcutta. If you look on the map, I believe you will appreciate this division. Then, aside from the All-India annual meeting, each of the remaining four meetings could be held jointly with a sub-section as one of the latter's three meetings.

I would like your views on this proposed organisational structure, as well as on possible cooperation with the local ITE and members of the IEE.

My own plans are as follows: from the 2-6 Sept. I am lecturing on computer design at the Tata Institute of Pundamental Research,

Bombay. On Friday 4 Sept. I am giving a public lecture under the auspices of the Institution of Engineers (India) in Bombay, on "Data-processing equipment from the designers point of view" to which I have sent out notices to all Bombay IRE members, asking them to remain after the meeting to discuss the formation of the section. The following week I am visiting Bangalore and Madras with a similar program. On 26 Sept. I am going to New Delhi for the same purpose.

I would appreciate your sending me at least two more sets of mailing labels. I am sure that the section will go ahead reapidly after my forthcoming trip.



One members, interested in the welfare of India informs me that at present there are sufficient number of members of I.R.E. in that country to apply for the initiation of a Chapter. I will lose no time to contact with the members just after my return. Hope the I.R.E. will not find any difficulty in permitting the initiation of its Chapter. There is an enormous field for development of Electronics in my country not only in Broadcasing but also in Instruments, etc.

Dear Mr. Graham:

I have for acknowledgment your letter of February 5 to Mr. G. W. Bailey, regarding the status of the proposed Section in India.

About three weeks ago, a member from India dropped into IRE Headquarters and seemed keenly interested in forming a Section in India, with its center in Bombay. I gathered from him that the idea of forming a Section has been entertained by Indian members of the IRE for some time. Our records show that there are 100 IRE members in India with about 25 of them living in Bombay - a sufficient number to form a Section. The visitor was supplied with the names and addresses of all members in India, a Section Manual, and a supply of application blanks and reference forms. I expect it will take several months for him to return to India and to organize a Section.

You may be interested in reports received from other areas regarding proposed Sections. There are very strong signs that a Section will be formed in Anchorage. Alaska, in the near future. Correspondence has been going on between Alaska and Headquarters for over half a year. An IRE member from Alaska stopped in at Headquarters about Christmas time, and talked over the situation with me. An IRE member in the Panama Canal Zone wrote in requesting information on forming a Section there last Fall. However, no further word has been received from him. I would expect that it would be somewhat difficult to maintain a Section in the Panama Canal Zone due to the fact that many of the personnel in that area are probably there on a temporary basis. I have also spoken with a member from Chile who indicated that there was some thought of breaking off from the Buenos Aires Section and forming a separate Section in Chile. I gave him what information I could and referred him to the Buenos Aires Section for further information and help. Nothing further has been heard on this matter. There has been quite a bit of correspondence between Headquarters and Mexico regarding forming a Section. Although this situation has not crystallized. I feel sure that we shall have a Section in Mexico in the not too distant future.

As regards activities in the United States, there seems to be very considerable activity in the South. A petition has been received for the formation of a Section at San Antonio, Texas, which will go before the March 2nd meeting of the Executive Committee. In addition, petitions are expected in the near future

from Amarillo, Texas, and Albuquerque, New Mexico. There has also been some thought of organizing a Section in Gainesville, Florida. However, this activity does not seem to be progessing very vigorously.

In answer to your question, no petition has been received from Sweden.

I have gone into considerable detail to bring you up to date, and in case you wish to include some of this information in the report of the Sections Coordinator.

Dear Mr. Balasundaram:

Thank you for your very courteous letter of April 1. We are happy to comply with your request regarding the names and addresses of active members residing in India, which information will be forwarded to you, today, under separate cover.

Your letter seems to indicate that you are interested in forming a new Institute Section in India, and for this purpose we are also forwarding to you, under separate cover, a copy of our Section Manual.

The first step is the determination of the boundary. After the boundary has been decided, the next step is to write out a petition stating the boundaries for the Section. This petition must be signed by not fewer than 25 members as specified in Section 38 of the Constitution. Your petition, if found to be in good order, will then be presented to the next meeting of the Executive Committee, which would probably recommend the formation of a new Section to the Board of Directors who would act upon it at their meeting the next day.

The next step would be the careful consideration of the Section Manual and the election of officers in accordance with the Manual. You might note at this time that the Chairman of the new Section must be of Member grade or higher. An Associate is not eligible to be Chairman.

When the new Section has been authorized by the Board of Directors and your officers elected in accordance with the Section Constitution, you are then eligible for a rebate of \$0.75 per member per year for every member in your Section up to 700 and \$0.90 per year for all members over 700. In addition, the Section is entitled to a rebate of \$10.00 per meeting per year up to a maximum of ten meetings per year.

If we can be of any further assistance to you, please do not hesitate to call upon us.
