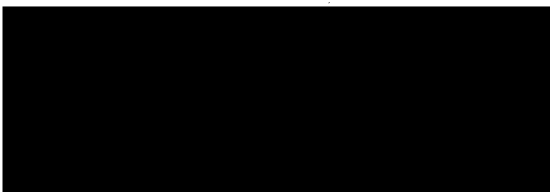

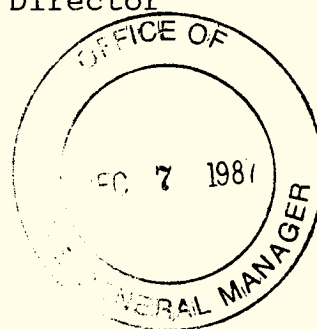

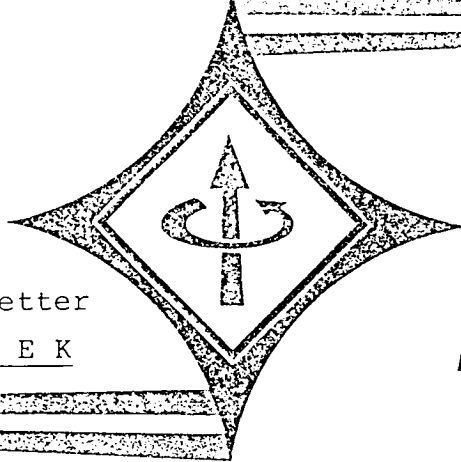

The official approval of the Hungary Section of the IEEE

On the 21st August 1987 in Mexico City the IEEE Regional Activities Board approved the Hungary Section (Dr. Hugo Rüchardt, Director of Region 8 cabled the good news).

Executive Committee Meeting

The Executive Committee of the Hungary Section (Prof.Tibor Vámos, Chairman; Prof.László Schnell, Vice-Chairman; Dr.Tamás Roska, Secretary; dr.Gábor Prónay Treasurer and responsible for the relations with MTESz; Mrs.Emőke L. Imre administrative coordinator) held a regular meeting in Budapest (in the MTA SzTAKI) on the 11th September, 1987. The main topics and conclusions were as follows.

The Hungary Section started with 50 members, presently there are 57 members (7 members provided their dues in US dollars). The annual due for 1988 will be 64 dollars, a four dollar increase in the regional assesment.

The petition for forming the Hungary Section has been duly signed as well as the proposal of the Section Bylaws has been slightly revised (according to the regulations of the Bylaws of the IEEE and the local regulations).

The Chairmen and members of two Committees of the Section has been nominated and approved as follows.

Nominations and Awards Committtee

Chairman : Prof.Sándor Csibi, Members: Prof.Árpád Csurgay and Prof.János Demetrovics .

Program and Conference Committee

Chairman : dr.Lajos Bálint, Members: dr. László Győrfi and dr. Gábor Péceli

The first technical meeting in August was successful (Prof. H.J. Carlin from Cornell University held an outstanding seminar). Further technical meetings will be organized by the Program and Conference Committee. Members are asked to direct their proposals to the Chairman and the members of this Committee.

According to our Bylaws (proposed) a Newsletter is circulated in the Section. It is compiled by the Secretary. All members are asked to send messages in the Newsletter (address: Dr. T. Roska, MTA SzTAKI, H-1014 Budapest, Uri u 49).

The Secretary of the Section will take part at the coming Region 8 Meeting near Ljubljana. He is responsible to forward the petition and to discuss the relevant actions needed for starting the regular life of the Section.

The Nominations and Awards Committee is asked to prepare the foundation of the "Best paper award of the Hungary Section, IEEE" (possible considering younger applicants). It will be given in every year (first in 1989) for an outstanding result published in the preceeding year. Prof. Tibor Vámos has been asked to contact the MTA-Soros foundation for asking a regular support providing one conference participation for the recipient of the award.

A section operations guide for our Section is to be elaborated (based on the IEEE guidelines as well as local needs and circumstances).

Members are advised to apply for Society memberships based on their own convertible currencies. Applications for Senior memberships are to be made also personally.

Your letter of 9th January to Mr Devenish and copies of your letter of 11th January to Dr Sinclair and the replies from him and from Mr MacAdam have all been passed to me as Director of Region 8.

May I say at once how delighted I was to read this correspondence and to learn of your interest in the formation of a Hungarian Section. I hope that your interest has been heightened by the paper enclosed by Mr MacAdam outlining the policy of the IEEE in countries where national societies already exist and with which the IEEE would wish to live in harmony to the mutual advantage of all.


The formation of a Section requires certain formalities such as preparation of a petition signed by a number of members, but these are not onerous and I have asked New York headquarters to send you full information.

If - as I hope - you are able to initiate Section activity, you may count on my full support and I know I speak for my colleagues on the Regional Committee that they would welcome a Hungarian Section representative joining our Regional Executive Committee meetings which are held twice a year in different European countries.

Regarding the matters in your letter to Mr Devenish, of course we will be pleased to include the Secretary of your Scientific Society on our mailing list for the Region 8 Newsletter, but I am afraid that limitation of space normally prevents us from including announcements of meetings with which the IEEE is not associated. However, in anticipation of your being able to form a Hungarian Section which would in future be able to co-sponsor such Conferences, I have asked the Editor to make an exception in this case and include a reference to your Budapest Symposium in our next Newsletter which will be mailed in mid March.

Dear Professor Almassy:

I was pleased to learn of your successful meeting with President Suran, General Manager Herz and Region 8 Director Poortvliet. At the request of Mr. Herz I am sending you information on establishing an IEEE Section in Hungary.

It is not a complicated process to form an IEEE Section. The names and signatures of a minimum of fifty members or non-members (who submitted their applications with/before transmittal of the petition) are required to be written on a form we supply. The petitioning members agree to adopt Section Bylaws and be governed by the Constitution, Bylaws and Policies and Procedures of the IEEE.

The completed petition is sent to IEEE Headquarters. Upon the recommendation of Director Poortvliet, the petition is submitted to the Regional Activities Board for final approval. The approximate time for completing this process is six weeks.

IEEE provides numerous resources to help volunteer officers run a Section including partial financial support. I have listed below a number of documents which should assist you in forming the Section. The following have been sent to you under separate cover via air mail:



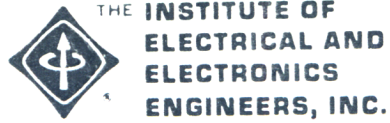

Dear Reg:

I was pleased to learn from your letter of July 17 that you have been in touch with Professor and Mrs. Valko and that you and Bob Winton had dinner with them. I agree with you that any Hungary agreement should not be closely patterned after the Polish experience, since our discussions at the Executive Committee level, while favorable to the Polish agreement, did not strongly endorse the idea of having SEP form the IEEE Poland Section. In fact, as you will see shortly from a letter which I am about to write to President Dryzek of SEP, the IEEE Executive Committee requested that a minor change be made in the agreement to have SEP "assist in the forming of the Poland Section of IEEE, " so as to leave some measure of initiative to our Polish members. In general, as I mentioned, the overall reaction of the Executive Committee was favorable, and the agreement was endorsed unanimously.

With regard to the Hungary matter, I have written to Mr. Miklos Philip some time ago requesting that he proceed with the formation of a Hungary Section, and in fact Mr. Charles F. Stewart of the IEEE Regional activities staff has, I believe, sent Mr. Philip membership applications as well as a petition blank for founding the Hungary Section.

Your suggestion that I write Mr. Philip telling him of the fact that I will be at the WFEO and WERC meetings in New York in mid-September and that I will be pleased to see Dr. Valko and Professor Gerendas at that time is a good one. I plan to do this, and will endeavor to set up a meeting with these gentlemen sometime between September 17 and 19.

Meanwhile, I look forward to seeing you and reviewing these matters in San Francisco prior to the time when this meeting in New York

takes place. Also, I intend to write to Mr. Dryzek telling him that I would like to have a better idea from him as to what time he now anticipates coming to New York to sign our IEEE/SEP agreement and we will let you know where things stand on this matter as soon as I have a reply.
