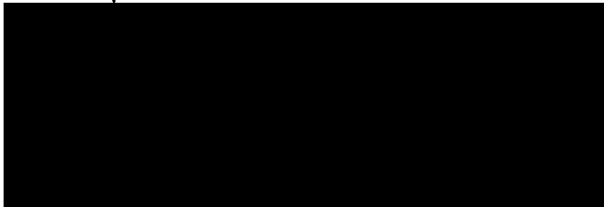

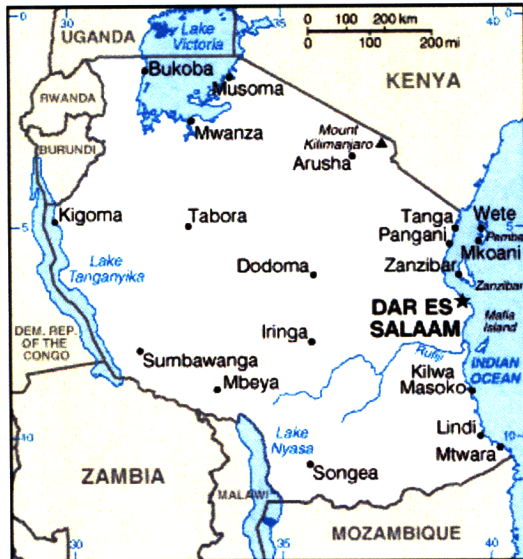

A petition was submitted with 20 qualified signatures to form the IEEE Tanzania Subsection. The boundaries of the proposed Subsection will be the country of Tanzania:



The formation of the IEEE Tanzania Subsection would enable existing members within East Africa to obtain more benefits from the IEEE. There would also be greater cooperation between East African countries resulting in the achievement of IEEE's global objectives. Joint seminars, meetings, conferences, exhibitions could take place resulting in greater membership development and exposure of IEEE's capabilities to the engineering fraternity.

This item was presented to RAB for approval in November 2005. At that time, it was proposed that the Tanzania subsection would be part of the Kenya Section. No action was taken on this proposal since the establishment of this unit would expand the boundaries of the Kenya Section outside the geographic boundaries of the country of Kenya.

In February 2006, RAB endorsed and recommended that the IEEE Bylaws be modified to allow subsections to report administratively to the Region. The proposed bylaw revisions will be discussed during the BoD meeting on 25 June.

Recommended Action:	The Regional Activities Board to approve the formation of the IEEE Tanzania Subsection in Region 8 contingent upon the IEEE Board of Directors approving the proposed revisions to IEEE Bylaws allowing Subsections to report administratively to a Region.
Financial Impact to RAB:	Funds have already been included in the Section Rebate budget.
Financial Impact to Region:	Determined by Region.
