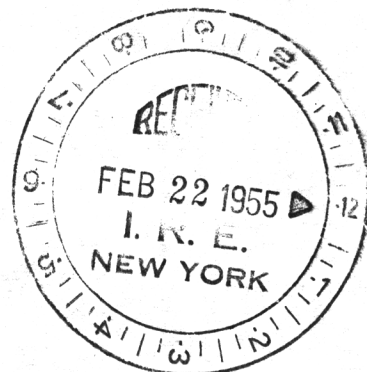

Confirming our conversation at the Board of Directors meeting, with reference to your letter of March 16, 1954, it is not necessary to obtain Executive Committee approval of the 1955 and 1956 Southwestern IRE Conferences.
