Dear Mr. LeRay:

The Baton Rouge Section IEEE Executive Committee met last Wednesday, September 3rd, and voted to increase the annual rebate of the Lafayette Subsection from \$60.00/year to \$120.00/year. Enclosed you will find a check for \$30.00 and this check along with my previous check of \$30.00 totals to the adjusted amount due the Subsection for its semi-annual rebate. We trust this amount is adequate to meet the Subsection's upcoming budget and should you find that another increase is needed, please let us know. We plan to hold our next Executive Committee meeting sometime around the middle of this fiscal year (around January, 1970), and any matters of the Subsection requiring their authority should be presented by that time.

Enclosed also you will find a copy of a letter from National Headquarters officially informing us that Rapides and Vernon Parishes have been assigned to the Lafayette Subsection. By latest count, the members of these two parishes along with those from the previous Subsection boundaries totals to 51 or enough to permit the Lafayette Subsection to request conversion to a section status. Our Executive Committee also discussed this matter and agreed that the Subsection should take steps as outlined in the IEEE Section Manual to seek section status. As you probably are aware, the signatures of 50 members are needed to petition National Headquarters on this matter, and for this reason we suggest that you increase the Subsection membership by an amount needed to obtain the required number of signatures.

Also discussed at our Executive Committee meeting was your request for the Baton Rouge Section to cede to the Subsection the parishes of Avoyelles, Grant, LaSalle, and Catahoula in addition to Rapides and Vernon Parishes. The Committee voted not to give up these four additional parishes at this time. As you probably are aware, we do not have members in these parishes, and the Subsection would not derive any benefit by increasing their territorial boundaries. Should we find at a later date that these parishes do have members and that they can enjoy a "travel advantage" by being assigned to the Subsection, then our Executive Committee will meet and reconsider its position.

The final item discussed at our Executive Committee meeting was the possibility of arranging a joint meeting with the Subsection. Anytime during the month of February would be agreeable with us, and either February 18th or February 19th would be ideal. At present we do not have a speaker and possibly you could suggest one. Possibly a "dutch treat" dinner meeting would be desirable and the meeting could be held anyplace within the Section/Subsection territory. We do not have any firm plans yet for such a meeting and we would like to hear your suggestions. We are hoping that the Subsection will have made the transition into a section by that time, and such a meeting could be coordinated for granting recognition to the newly formed Lafayette Section. Please let me know, at your earliest convenience, the Subsection's feelings and suggestions for a joint meeting this coming February.

As an additional matter of information, you may be interested to know that I am sending Mr. Amy a complete up-to-date list of all members in the Lafayette Subsection, including those from Rapides and Vernon Parishes. Mr. Amy should receive this list by the end of this week.

I hope this letter is informative and beneficial to you and I trust that you will pass the information contained to the other Lafayette Subsection officers. If I can be of further service, please let me know.

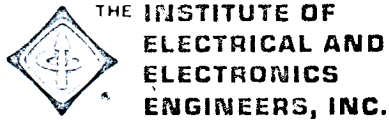

We note that you have sent a copy of your September 15 letter to Directors Daussman and Cory, and we will therefore wait for their decisions in this matter.

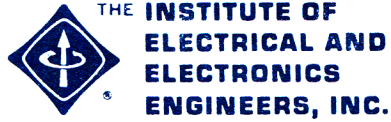

The Lafayette Section is a relatively new section and we are unfamiliar with the procedures we should follow in this matter. Please advise in order that we may comply with any requirements of National.

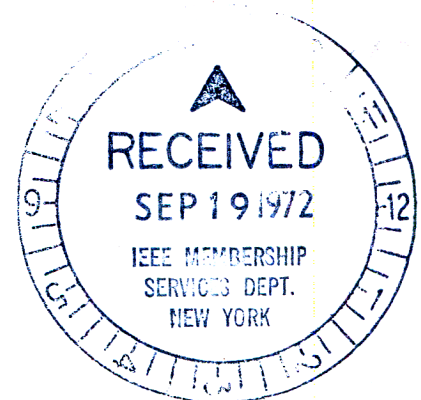

The Executive Committee of the Baton Rouge Section of the IEEE has been studying the problem of local apathy, etc., in the members. One problem came to light with respect to a number of the section members regarding their travel to section meetings. These members live in the parishes of Rapides and Vernon in central Louisiana.

The problem lies in the roads between their homes and Baton Rouge and in particular the 40 mile stretch west of Baton Rouge. This piece carries practically all the east-west traffic in the south that does not go through New Orleans and then some of that. The road is very narrow and has a very high accident rate. The local people do not travel that way unless an absolute necessity. These members will not risk this road just to attend IEEE meetings.

To partially solve this it is proposed to transfer the parishes of Rapides and Vernon from the geographical district of the Baton Rouge Section to the Lafayette Subsection. Our Executive Committee has studied this matter and agreed it is the proper thing to do. Would you please consider the matter and if it meets with your approval so recommend to the IEEE Executive Committee.

This procedure has been recommended to us by Emily Sirjane, Manager Membership Services.

We believe that the dozen or so members residing in these parishes will be able to derive many more benefits from their membership and also to participate more actively with this arrangement. It is very likely that their interests are more closely allied with those of the Lafayette Subsection too.
