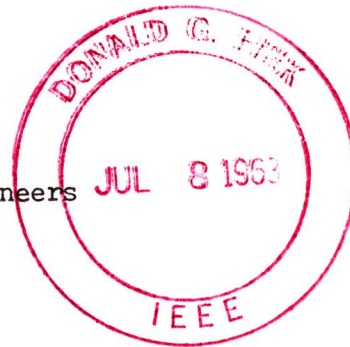



1. We, the representatives for the Richmond Subsection of AIEE and that part of the Tidewater Virginia Subsection of IRE located in the area noted in 2 below do hereby jointly petition for recognition of the merged activities into the Richmond Section IEEE, effective May 1, 1963.

Written approval of the territorial boundaries set forth above is contained in a letter dated April 5, 1963 to Mr. John W. Davis, Director - Region III, from Mr. R. F. Wille, Secretary of the AIEE-IRE Sections Committee.

3. Membership of the Richmond Section IEEE, approximately 240, exceeds the established minimum requirements, and can be authenticated by records of Headquarters IEEE.

4. The Richmond Section IEEE will abide by the Constitution for Sections approved by the Board of Directors IEEE.

5. The following local bylaws will be in effect upon implementation of the Richmond Section IEEE.

a. Fiscal Year - of the Section is established to run 1 July thru 30 June of the following year.


b. Annual Meeting - will be in May of each year.

c. The latest edition of Robert's Rules of Order will be the Standard Parliamentary Authority.


d. The Chairman in office at the time of the Summer Meeting of the

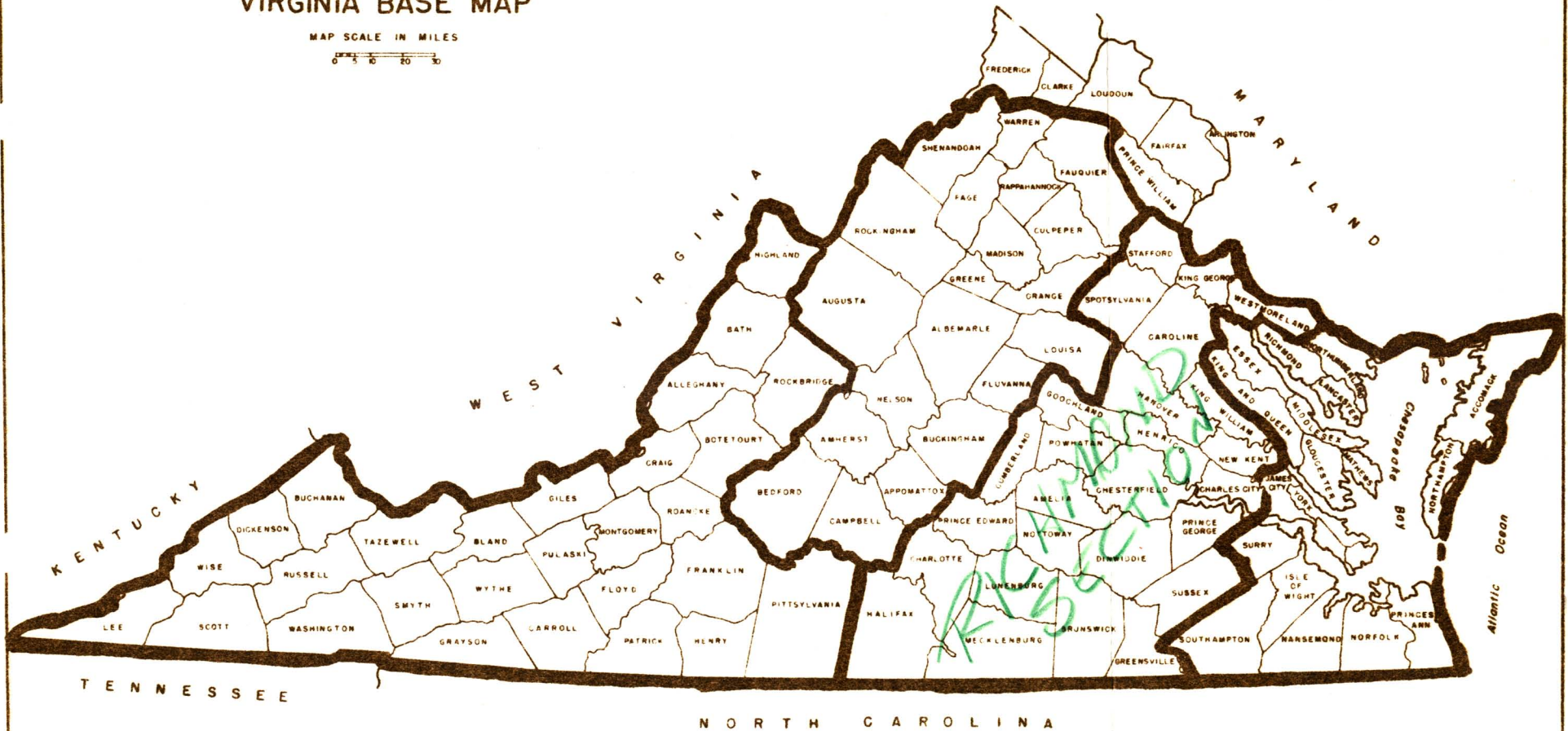
