Dear Warren:

Here is a draft of the letter I would expect to send to all of our Section Chairmen on February 3. In order to get it out on February 3, I have, of course, anticipated our meetings of January 31, but not harmfully, I hope, unless they or your Board meeting of February 2 produce negative majority views. I will be out of pocket from February 1 until Saturday evening, February 3, and I have asked George Bailey to arrange with you during our panel session on January 31 to be contacted by you either after your Board meeting on February 2 or on the morning of February 3.
