Dear Mr. Holmes:

I'm happy to enclose two copies of my Chairman's Report for the 1962 - 63 season of IRE /IEEE. I'm sending one copy directly to Headquarters and additional copy to the current chairman, C. W. Vadersen.

You will note that the financial report is strictly a cash-on-hand type of report. The final audited report will, I hope, include not only cash, but all assets and liabilities. I'm writing to Mr. Van Duyne to request that this be done.

I hope you have been on the mailing list to receive the New Jersey Newsletter. If not, please let me know so that we can add your name.

I have not included information on membership because we do not have what we consider an accurate breakdown from Headquarters. The closest information I can give you is that we have 6128 members to whom the New Jersey Newsletter is mailed each month. This includes IRE, AIEE and students. In addition to the 6128 we send out approximately 150 to others, such as ad agencies, other sections, etc.

In our report we indicated the desirability of operating jointly with a University, yet we showed an average attendance of only 90 for the Spring Lecture Series at Fairleigh-Dickinson University, whereas we showed 98 for the Fall Lecture Series at the Montclair High School. Offhand this would appear to cause an opposite conclusion. It happened, however, that due to a changeover in management of our Newsletter, billboard and mailing notices did not arrive in time for Fairleigh-Dickinson to make their announcements. I'm sure that the attendance would have been at least an additional 50 if this condition had not existed.

If the information in the report needs additional clarification, or if you need additional information, please let me know.

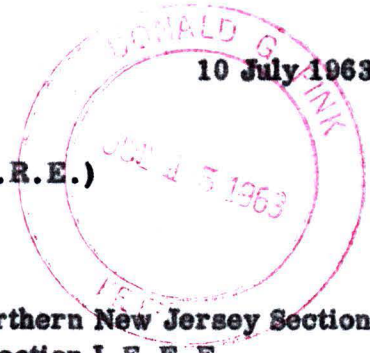

The above slate was elected at a joint Section meeting on May 8, 1963 by voice vote.

Audit

The financial condition of the Section at the close of the 1962 - 63 season is shown on the attached reports. Auditing of these reports is expected to be completed this month and copies of the audited report will be sent to the Regional Director, Region 1 and to headquarters immediately upon its receipt.

Some General Notes

1. This has been a particularly interesting year due to the merger of A.I.E.E. and I.R.E. I want to express my appreciation for the guidance given to the Section by Frank A. Polkinghorn, Chairman of the Merger Liaison Committee for I.R.E., and to John Schwanhausser, Chairman of the N. J. Div., A.I.E.E. who acted on behalf of the A.I.E.E. It would be difficult to imagine a smoother merger operation of two such large sections. Several meetings of the officers of the sections and Mr. Polkinghorn were held, followed by joint executive meetings. At these meetings it was decided (1) to make the full merger changeover at the May 1963 Section meeting (2) to operate jointly for the January to May 1963 period, but for each section to continue its pre-arranged schedule of meetings, lectures and field trips (3) to increase the circulation of the NEWSLETTER to include an estimated 2000 A.I.E.E. members without special transfer of funds from A.I.E.E. to I.R.E. to cover the cost (4) to merge funds of A.I.E.E. and I.R.E. and to complete the auditing during July 1963 (5) to appoint all committee chairmen by the June 26, 1963 Executive Committee meeting so that work could be started immediately on the programs for all meetings and the Fall Lecture Series starting in September 1963. A completely merged I.E.E.E. Section is currently in operation.

2. The following thoughts regarding Section operations may be of interest to the Regional Director of Region 1, and to Headquarters I. E. E. E.

The attendance at Section meetings will probably continue to be a small percentage of the membership as the number of PTG Chapters increases. Members will probably choose to go to meetings in their own special field of interest, and not go to Section meetings, unless the subject is of particular interest. A suggestion has been received that might be worth serious consideration on the part of Section executive committee members. It is that the Section program committee work with each PTG Chapter program committee to select a topic, speaker, and date that will be of prime interest to this PTG, and then to promote the meeting as a joint PTG and Section meeting. Do this once a year for each active PTG in the Section. Another suggestion that deserves a trial is the use of field trips for section meetings. All Section and PTG field trips during the past year have been particularly well attended. These trips could be combined with a socializing period either before, during, or after the field trip. Some of the former A.I.E.E. members have been particularly interested in the socializing feature, and feel that it is of much more value to members than might at first appear. One or a combination of the above ideas may be of value to other sections that are having Section attendance problems.

3. Joint Lecture Series with a University may appeal to some Sections as a way of introducing more students to activities of I. E. E. E. and of assisting the University in serving the scientific community. The University is probably able to provide adequate facilities for the lectures. It is the feeling of some members that co-operating with a University in a lecture series gives the series a prestige that it does not have when it is held in a high school or some other public building. Our I.R.E. Spring Lecture Series, held at Fairleigh Dickinson University, was well attended throughout the entire series of ten lectures.

4. I believe that prompt attention must be given to the formation of new groups to meet the needs of former A.I.E.E. members whose interests do not lie with the present PTG's. Delay in doing this may result in the formation of a new organization by those former A.I.E.E. members who now feel that they are deserted or that their status is denigrated when told they should form new PTG's.

Gentlemen:

In the fall of 1947 the Northern New Jersey Subsection of the New York Section of the IRE was formed. Since that time the Subsection has matured to such a point that the officers for the 1953-54 season felt it incumbent upon themselves to study the desirability of graduation to full section status. A committee under the chairmanship of Dr. James McRae had already studied the problem of subsection status in the New York Section in 1952 with the following conclusion, which I quote from its final report of May 15, 1952:

"The general conclusion of the committee was that each of the present subsections should become a section, and that a regional mechanism should be set up to coordinate the program of meetings, conferences, symposia and lecture series throughout the Region 2 area."

In the following year, the Long Island Subsection became a full section.

Further study of the situation in New Jersey was undertaken by an ad hoc committee under the chairmanship of Mr. Jerry Minter, first chairman of the Northern New Jersey Subsection. The conclusion of this committee as reported to the present Northern New Jersey Subsection chairman in a letter dated July 24, 1953 was as follows:

"After considerable discussion it was unanimously agreed that the Northern New Jersey Subsection should become a full section.

"Additional responsibilities attendant upon full section status can readily be met by selection of officers from our large IRE membership in this area.

"Our Ad Hoc Committee agrees with the conclusions reached by Dr. J. W. McRae's Committee Report dated May 15, 1952 with regard to regional coordination, symposia, lecture series and other joint activities."

During February and March of 1954, officers of the Northern New Jersey Subsection, the New York Section, the Long Island Section, and the Director of Region 2 explored the problems of close regional coordination. Agreement was reached at the annual meeting of the Region 2 Committee regarding a positive jointly-sponsored program to be implemented during the 1954-55 season.

A poll of the membership of the Northern New Jersey Subsection was conducted during March of 1954 to ascertain their wishes regarding full section status. Copies of the explanatory statement and ballot employed are attached to this letter. Of 2103 members polled, 1179 had voted by March 31, the closing date for the balloting. Of these, 1113 signed ballots petitioning the Institute to form the Northern New Jersey Section of the IRE with boundaries as presently established for the Northern New Jersey Subsection, namely inclusion of the counties Bergen, Essex, Hudson, Morris, Passaic, Sussex, Union and Warren. Of the remaining 66 ballots received by March 31, 56 voted against the change in status, 9 did not vote either way, and 1 voted both ways. As a matter of interest, 17 additional invalid ballots have been received as of April 6, all in favor of full section status.

In view of the clear wish of the Northern New Jersey Subsection membership, it is my pleasure and duty as Chairman of the Subsection to submit their petition to the Institute of Radio Engineers, in accordance with Section 3.3.2.63 of the Bylaws of the Constitution of the IRE, to form the Northern New Jersey Section. In the event that the petition be granted, the signers of this petition have agreed to abide by the Constitution for Sections.

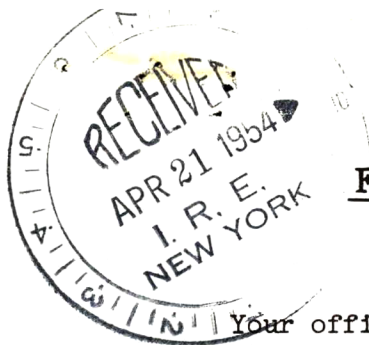

FULL SECTION STATUS FOR NORTHERN NEW JERSEY?

Your officers believe the time has now arrived for the Northern New Jersey Subsection to graduate to full-section status. This step is desirable because of the increased prestige accorded to a full section. It is logical because of the size and maturity of our group and will improve our ability to serve our membership adequately.

We are now in our seventh successful year of operation, growing at a rate of 15-20% per year. Our present 2103 members will make the Northern New Jersey Section the sixth largest in IRE.

THE ADVANTAGES OF FULL SECTION STATUS ARE:

The increased prestige will ease the procurement of top-notch speakers and make committee work more attractive.

Our ties to IRE Headquarters and to the Regional Organization will be direct.

Your local organization will directly administer a larger share of your present dues.

SOME PROBLEMS ASSOCIATED WITH FULL SECTION STATUS ARE:

Regional Organization: At present the New York Section operates symposia and lecture series for the benefit of the entire region. These functions must be transferred to the Regional Organization, which our membership will participate in and help support. The Regional Organization is now preparing plans to take on these responsibilities.

Financial: The regional activities and Professional Group Chapters must be financially supported in part by our section. Income will be available to defray these costs because of the percentage of membership dues allocated by Headquarters to full sections.

Meeting Notices: Information on New York Section meetings must continue to be mailed to our members. Of several satisfactory solutions to this problem, your officers propose to include New York Section activities information on the New Jersey notice.

To Which Section Will You Belong? Members who live in Northern New Jersey* but work in New York, or vice versa, control their section affiliation by proper choice of mailing address for their Proceedings, since this determines the section to which a member belongs.

(Footnote: * Bergen, Essex, Hudson, Morris, Passaic, Sussex, Union, and Warren Counties)

BACKGROUND

Your IRE is and must be evolutionary in nature to serve the needs of an expanding membership working in increasingly specialized fields. The present pattern of our evolution is seen in the growth of the professional group system and in the development of new sections from subsections. Last year a distinguished committee under the chairmanship of Dr. James McRae made a careful study of the problems of the New York Area as a whole, and a committee of past chairmen of the Long Island Subsection studied the needs of that area in particular. As a result of these studies, Long Island became a full section last May. The conclusions of the McRae Committee apply to Northern New Jersey also, and they have been fully endorsed by a committee of past chairmen of the Northern New Jersey Subsection under the able leadership of Mr. Jerry Minter.



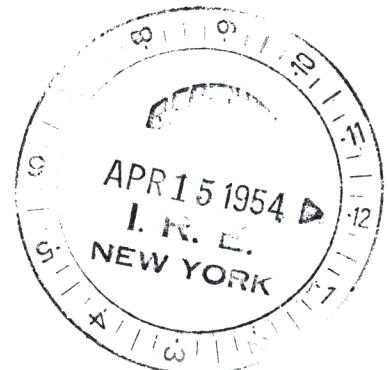

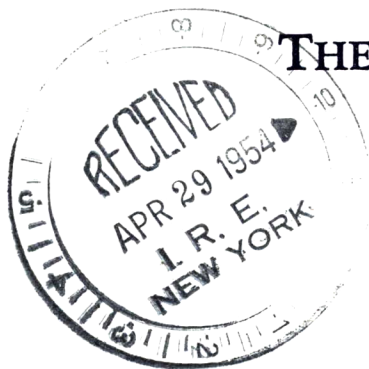
