the petition

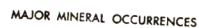
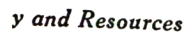

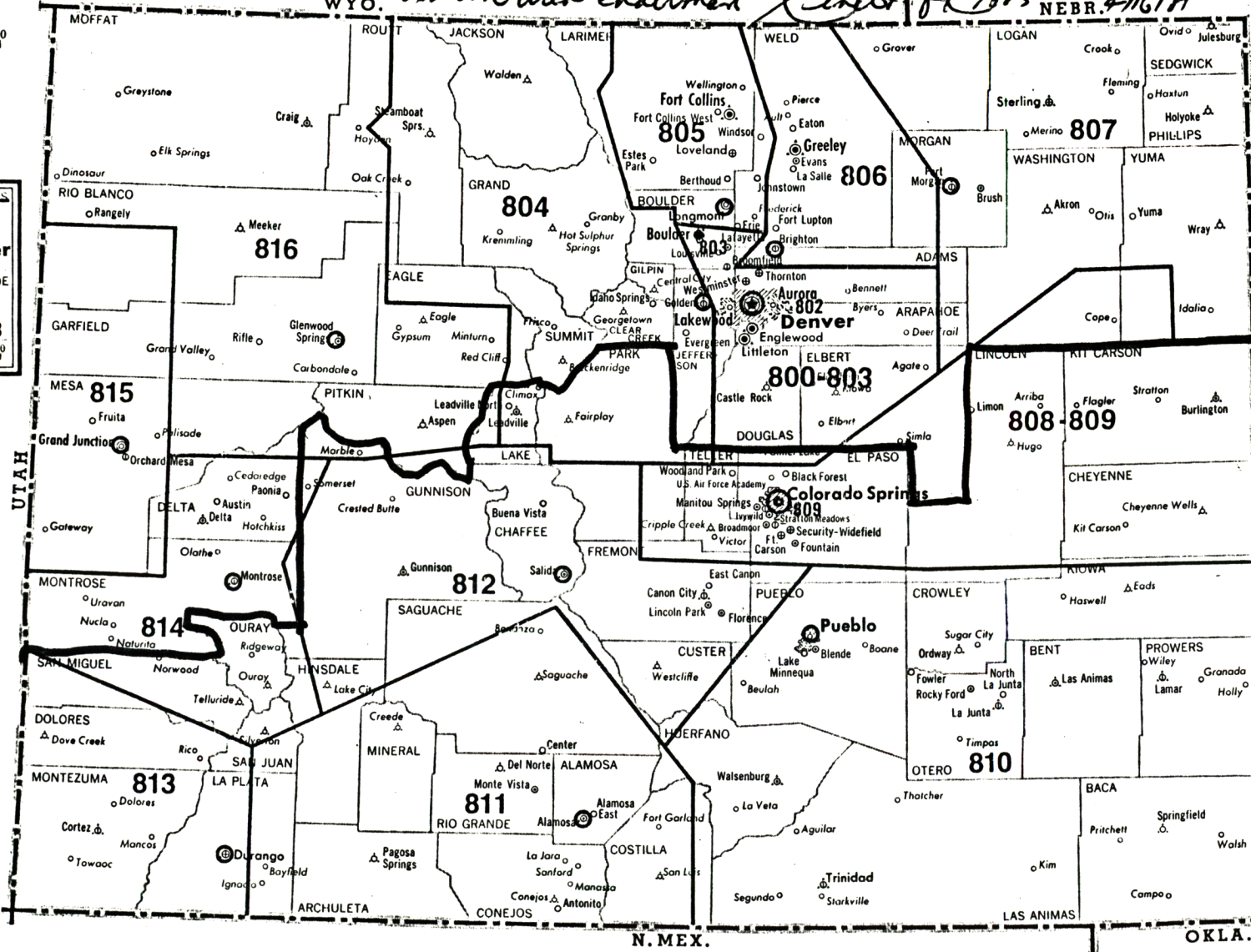
