Dear Bill:

On behalf of the Northern Virginia Subsection Executive Committee, I wish to submit the attached petition for section status for your consideration and comment. Pending any modifications, we respectfully request that you present this petition to the next Regional Activities Board meeting in May 1976.

By way of historical sidelight, the subsection has been actively operating since its formation in June 1973. During that period, the subsection has sponsored a variety of meetings, tours and seminars and has promoted active committee work with emphasis in Continuing Education, Membership, and Professional Activities. We have recently begun planning for a conference to be held in Northern Virginia sometime in spring 1977 on the topic of application of computer technology in the biomedical sciences. This conference will be co-sponsored with the Medical College of Virginia and the IEEE Computer Society. Finally, we have sought, and will continue to seek, a close working relationship with the Washington Section while promoting member activities in the Institute at the subsection level.

The reasons for submitting this petition are stated in the attached white paper, A Discussion of the Petition to the IEEE Regional Activities Board to Form a Northern Virginia Section, 29 January 1976, together with the basic understandings we would seek with the Washington Section should this petition be approved. At such a time, the two executive committees could hold a joint meeting to work out details of these understandings.

In summary, the enclosed postcard petitions contain approximately four-hundred (400) signatures of Member, Senior Member, and Fellow grades, thirteen (13) signatures of Associate grade, and nine (9) signatures of Student grade. We have culled all cards of obviously non-eligible individuals (by virtue of residence or non-membership). These enclosed cards represent the remaining eligible signatures. The postcard method of circulating the petition may be somewhat unorthodox and perhaps not allowed by strict interpretation of the bylaws. If there is some question of the validity of this method, we ask then that the petition be based on the 60+ signatures on the earlier petition circulated in sheet form. (Note that there are some duplicate names on the sheets and cards.) With regard to the statement of concurrence by the Washington Section as required by IEEE Bylaws, I have asked Al Reiner to provide you with a statement of the views of the Washington Section Executive Committee on the petition.

TEXT OF PETITION

ATTACHMENT B

A DISCUSSION OF THE PETITION
TO THE IEEE REGIONAL ACTIVITIES BOARD TO FORM A
NORTHERN VIRGINIA SECTION

29 January 1976

Various topics and issues related to basic section operations must be addressed in depth prior to a formal determination of Section status for the Northern Virginia Subsection. This paper discusses those concerns for which a common current understanding is sought to form a basis for meaningful and cooperative future efforts in providing the maximum usable services to the members of the Institute in the Washington area. These areas consist of:

- (a) bulletin,
- (b) Group/Society chapters,
- (c) finances,
- (d) local office support, and
- (e) effective date of formation.

A section bulletin is the primary means of communication to the membership. It is important not to limit or inhibit the distribution of information needed by the members. The performance of member services could be executed by two local sections with two separate bulletins -- a great portion of which would be duplicate or near duplicate announcements. The matter of economy of scale must be weighed against the advantage of an independent -- perhaps competitive or contrasting -- editorial policy. Given the possibility of reaching middle ground (editorially), it appears more advantageous for both sections to publish joint rather than separate bulletins. An attractive means for accomplishing the "editorial middle ground" is to allow the editor job to rotate between the sections (so long as willing volunteers can be identified) with the chief associate editor being named by the other section to succeed the editor after either a fixed term of office or the editor's resignation.

The subject of Group/Society chapters is fully treated in the IEEE Bylaws, in the IEEE Group's Section of the Technical Manual, and in the Section Manual. The relationship between Group/Society chapters and multiple sections in one geographic area are described in detail in paragraph 406.8 of the IEEE Bylaws. This paragraph is reproduced here:

"A Group Chapter or Joint Group Chapter may be established by the procedures defined in Bylaws 406.2, 406.3 and 406.7 to cover the territory of two or more contiguous Sections, or an Affiliation, or a Council, provided the necessary approval is obtained by all concerned. The petition shall identify the entity assuming responsibility for the Group Chapter management. That entity shall receive the Group Chapter member and Affiliate allowances and rebates for the Group Chapter meetings.

In Regions 8, 9 and 10, a Group Chapter or a Joint Group Chapter may be established in the Region upon the recommendation of the Regional Director, provided that circumstances do not favor its formation in a Section or contiguous Sections of the Region."

In addition to following the guidelines offered by the Section Manual, it is proposed that a common understanding that the formation of duplicate technical chapters in the immediate area of one another be discouraged. Relative geographic spread should remain the basic reason for formation of new chapters of existing groups and societies.

The continuity of existing member services requires a sound financial base for a new Northern Virginia Section. It is proposed that this base be logically derived from the existing section's reserves pro-rated to membership and done in a manner which adequately provides the reserves necessary for the new section without severely disrupting the financial planning of the existing section.

The need for local office support in the operation of a section can vary from a luxury to a necessity depending primarily upon the size (membership) and level of activity of the section. The Washington Section is the largest in Region 2 in terms of membership and one of the largest in the Institute. Indeed, other sections such as Philadelphia and Boston maintain paid office support and use this support to their advantage in expanding section activities in conferences, seminars, etc.

There should be no disputing that the Washington Section has enough members to continue some type of paid office support. Analogous to the philosophy of bulletin operation, it would be desirable for economy of scale to maintain a single office to serve both the Washington Section and a new Northern Virginia Section.

For planning purposes of all parties involved, it is advantageous to specify a timetable for the orderly conversion in status of Northern Virginia Subsection to a section. It is proposed that 1 July 1976 be the target date for the formal transition to section status for Northern Virginia Subsection. The advantages of this time are:

- (1) coincidence with the rebate period used by IEEE Headquarters,
- (2) ability to formulate a broad base of volunteer support during the summer months lull in meeting activity to prepare for the remainder of the year,
- (3) it enables the existing Executive Committees of the Washington Section and Northern Virginia Subsection to execute detailed planning during the next five months.

Motivating Considerations Related to the Section Formation Petition

The various factors associated with the decision to petition the IEEE Regional Activities Board to become a section are as follows:

- Member Involvement

Additional expansion at the section level in any geographic area with as large a number of members as the Washington Section affords the advantage of bringing more members into the mainstream of Institute affairs through offices, committee work or simply member activities as individually desired. This situation supplements the development of additional talent for other Institute positions.

- Close Member Contact

One statement which is frequently made by members in the Washington, D.C. metropolitan area is that a specific activity or meeting would be interesting to attend but is just too far away to be convenient. Although we would hope that most members would make their decisions to participate based on factors other than convenience, it cannot be denied that it is a consideration. The current and projected energy consciousness will cause this situation to become more acute.

The allowable level of personal member contact and, hence, responsiveness to member needs in such areas as Continuing Education, Professional Activities, and Membership and Transfers would be enhanced by formation of a new and smaller section in Northern Virginia.

- Direct Representation in Institute Affairs at the Regional Level

The establishment of smaller sections in the Washington, D.C. area would provide for a more direct and balanced presentation of members' views to the Regional Activities Board.

- Finances

The flexibility attainable in financing member services in a new section via a separate budget would be useful. Formerly, there was a very strong financial incentive to form multiple smaller sections when the non-uniform member rebate schedule was used by IEEE Headquarters. With the present uniform rebate schedule, there is still some financial incentive to form a new section in the form of the \$200.00 basic section rebate.
