Sister Section Agreement
IEEE Syracuse Section, IEEE East Tennessee Section, IEEE Central Tennessee Section, IEEE Memphis Section, IEEE Tennessee Council and IEEE Kerala Section

1. Syracuse Section, East Tennessee Section, Central Tennessee Section, Memphis Section, Tennessee Council and Kerala Sections by mutual consent have entered into a long term, voluntary relationship for the purpose of exchanging ideas and experiences on how to benefit from each other's operations.
2. This initial agreement is for a five-year term and does not imply any financial or legal relationship. It can be renewed further on mutual consent. This is one of the IEEE projects meant for the benefit of members of each respective section. It will take effect on January 1, 2009.
3. The desire and basis for a Sister Section Agreement between five sections and one Council has been approved by the Section Executive Committees of the three Sections, Tennessee Council and is submitted here for the approval by Directors of Region 1 (Dr. Howard Michel), Region 3 (Mr. William Ratcliff) and Region 10 (Dr. Janina Mazierska). This interface between sister sections shall be primarily by email, and may involve communications between officers with similar responsibilities.
4. Initial activities will be established by the prime contacts of Syracuse Section (Dr. Prasanta Ghosh, 2008 Chair), East Tennessee Section (Terry Kurtz, 2008 Chair), Central Tennessee Section (Abraham George, 2008 Vice Chair), Memphis Section (Susan Ronning, 2008 Chair), Tennessee Council (Dr. Tim Bigelow, 2008 Chair) and Kerala Section (Dr. Amarnath Raja, 2008 Chair). As interest develops in a particular area, other officers may communicate directly as sub committee established by the respective section/council. The sub-committee will submit a summary report to the respective primary contacts. The prime contacts plan to submit a summary report on their activities/progress to their respective Regional Directors once a year.

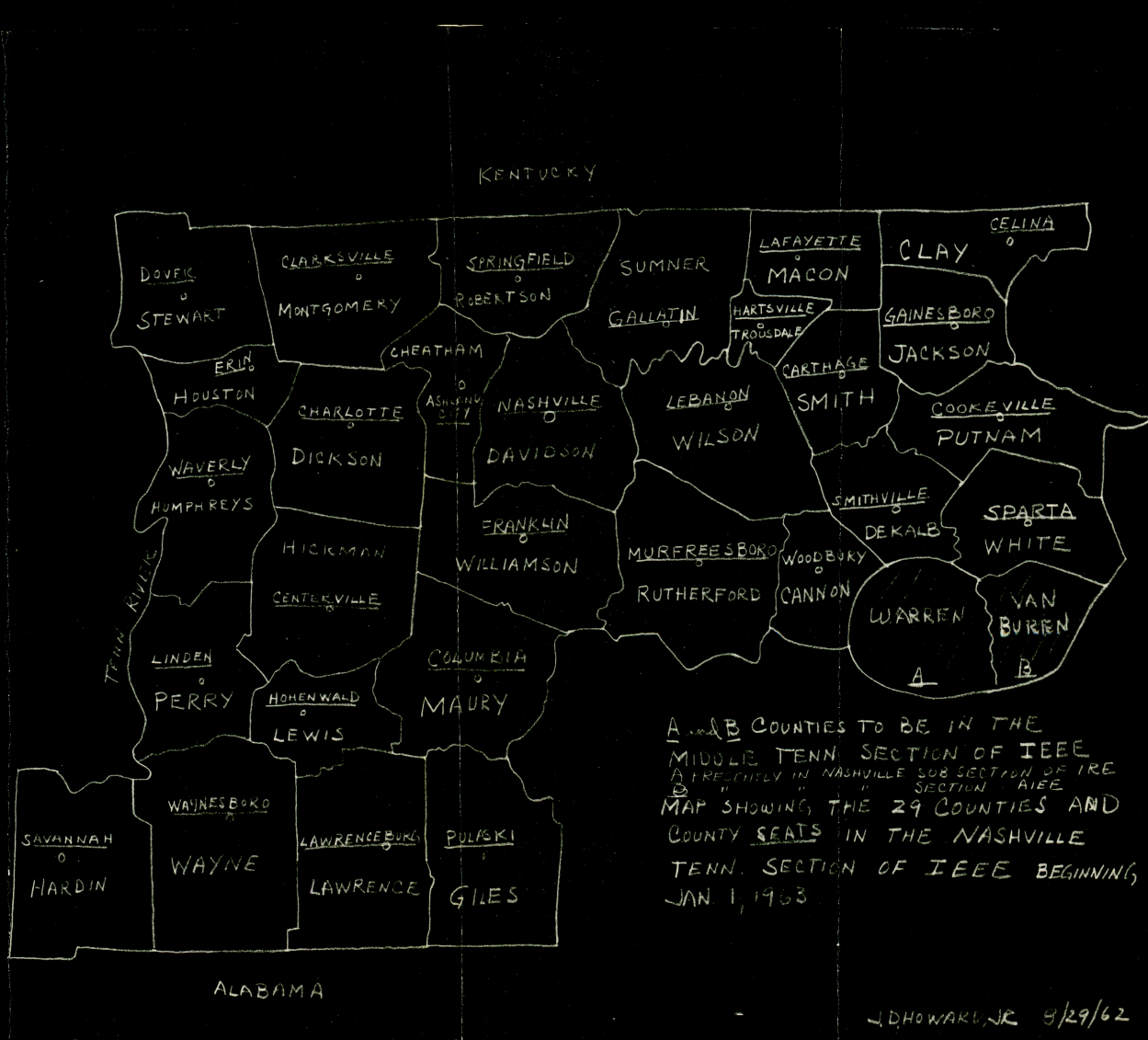

Dear Mr. Shelton:

We have received a letter from Mr. O. W. Towner, Technical Director, WHAS, Inc., Louisville, Kentucky, in which he requests that we send to you information on the formation of an IRE Section.

We are mailing to you today, under separate cover, a copy of our Section Manual which will give you complete information on the formation and operation of Sections of the Institute, together with a supply of Membership application blanks and information folders.

In order to form a Section, a petition, signed by not less than 25 members of Associate grade or higher, who have PROCEEDINGS mailing addresses within the territory of the proposed Section, must be submitted to the Board of Directors. The petition should also indicate those counties which the proposed Section's territory will cover.

Upon receipt of the Section Manual, I would suggest that you refer to the map attached to the back cover which shows the Section territories. You will note that on page 28 all the states are listed which are now part of the present territory of the Atlanta Section. When you have decided on what territory your Section will include, it will be necessary for you to negotiate with whatever Sections now serve the proposed territories, in order to get their permission for transferring any territory to your proposed Section. Such approval, by whatever Sections are involved, should be indicated to headquarters either by you or by the officers of the other Sections at the time the petition is submitted.

As an alternative, a sub-section of the Atlanta Section could be formed. A sub-section is an official sub-division of a Section and is operated and financed by a Section. The advisability of whether or not to form a sub-section is entirely in the hands of the officers of the Section.

If we can be of any further service to you, such as supplying you with an up-to-date list of the members in your area, please let us know.
