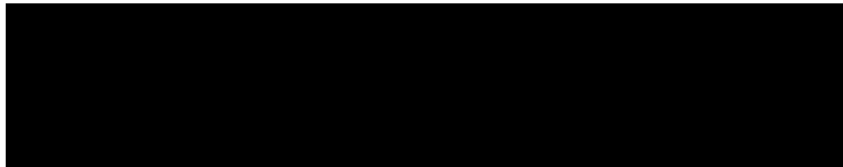

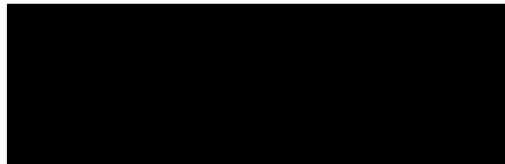

Dear Miss Sirjane:

Attached herewith is a petition to the Board of Directors of IRE for permission to establish an IRE Section to be known as the "Rio de Janeiro, Brazil Section". In Portuguese it would be Seção Rio de Janeiro, Brasil do IRE. The proposed section would be in the Federal District and would include the whole State of Rio de Janeiro which is quite small. The petition is signed by a total of 43 persons.

Eighteen of the 42 signatures are of Fellow, Senior Member, Member, or Associate Grade Members residing in the area of the proposed Section. Sixteen of the signatures are by persons applying for Associate Grade Membership. Completed application forms for these applicants are enclosed. The forms appear to be filled out completely and thus can be processed without delay. When they are processed in your office I believe that these names on the petition will be valid. When they are approved there will be 33 valid signatures on the petition and I trust that the Board of Directors will give approval without further delay because my time in Rio is growing shorter.

The additional 9 applicants for Member Grade who have also signed the petition can be processed in due time without holding up the formation of the new Section. Incidentally, all letters sent to Brazil should be sent Air Mail. Letters sent by regular mail take a month or more, one way.

It is noted in Section 26 of the IRE Constitution that entrance fees and dues are payable within six months from notification of election. This provision will be helpful to the people here because there is very much red-tape for individuals to get permission to send dollars to the United States. They want to form the new Section and handle the payment of entrance fees and dues through the Secretary of the Section who will collect from each of the members in cruzeiros. The Section Secretary will go through the red-tape for all the members and send you the dollars to cover all the members at once. The possibility of doing this has greatly encouraged old members to remain in IRE and has helped attract new members.

Enclosed is a dittoed list of the names and addresses on the petition which is easier to read than the original. Also included is an application form for transfer from Member to Senior Member grade by Walter Heininger who has done most of the work in circulating the petition and contacting prospective new members. The pink list gives the names and addresses of persons used as references in the applications for Member and Senior Member Grade. The


names on the list are keyed to the letters on the forms.

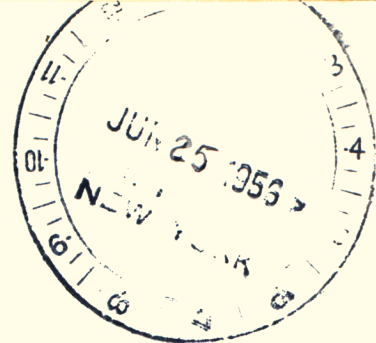
In many of the forms you will note that the persons have been educated in radio and electronic engineering at either the Escola Tecnica do Exercito in Rio, which is sponsored by the Brazilian Army, or the Instituto Tecnológico de Aeronáutica near São Paulo and sponsored by the Brazilian Air Force. The Instituto has a five year full time course of study and the graduates are well trained and have at least the equivalent of a BS degree in the U. S. I have visited this school. According to Walter Heininger, the Escola Tecnico do Exercito which conducts a five year course in radio and electronic engineering gives training at least the equivalent to a BS degree in the U. S.

Please let me know if the petition is satisfactory and the general method of procedure for establishing the proposed new Section. If it is desirable, I could prepare a brief statement on "The State of Radio and Electronics in Brazil" similar to the one by Prof. Mahmoud on Egypt in the January 1956 Proceedings on the occasion of the formation of an IRE Section in Egypt.

Attached herewith is a petition to the Board of Directors of IRE for permission to establish an IRE Section to be known as the "Rio de Janeiro, Brazil Section". In Portuguese it would be Seção Rio de Janeiro, Brasil do IRE. The proposed section would be in the Federal District and would ^{include} the whole State of Rio de Janeiro which is quite small. The petition is signed by a total of 43 persons.

Eighteen of the 42 signatures are of Fellow, Senior Member, Member, or Associate Grade Members residing in the area of the proposed Section. Sixteen of the signatures are by persons applying for Associate Grade Membership. Completed application forms for these applicants are enclosed. The forms appear to be filled out completely and thus can be processed without delay. When they are processed in your office I believe that these names on the petition will be valid. When they are approved there will be 33 valid signatures on the petition and I trust that the Board of Directors will give approval without further delay because my time in Rio is growing shorter.

The additional 9 applicants for Member Grade who have also signed the petition can be processed in due time without holding up the formation of the new Section. Incidentally all letters sent to Brazil should be sent Air Mail. Letters sent by regular mail take a month or more, one way.

It is noted in Section 26 of the IRE Constitution that entrance fees and dues are payable within six months from notification of election. This provision will be helpful to the people here because there is very much red-tape for individuals to get permission to send dollars to the United States. They want to form the new Section and handle the payment of entrance fees and dues through the Secretary of the Section who will collect from each of the members in cruzeiros. The Section Secretary will go through the red-tape for all the members and send you the dollars to cover all the members at once. The possibility of doing this has greatly encouraged old members to remain in IRE and has helped attract new members.

Enclosed is a dittoed list of the names and addresses on the petition which is easier to read than the original. Also included is an application form for transfer from Member to Senior Member grade by Walter Heininger who has done most of the work in circulating the petition and contacting prospective new members. The pink list gives the names and addresses of persons used as references in the applications

for Member and Senior Member Grade. The names on the list are keyed to the letters on the forms.

In many of the forms you will note that the persons have been educated in radio and electronic engineering at either the Escola Technica do Exercito in Rio which is sponsored by the Brazilian Army, or the Instituto Tecnológico de Aeronáutico near São Paulo and sponsored by the Brazilian Air Force. The Instituto has a five year full time course of study and the graduates are well trained and have at least the equivalent of a BS degree in the U. S. I have visited this school. According to Walter Heininger the Escola Technico do Exercito which conducts a five year course in radio and electronic engineering gives training equivalent to a BS degree in the U. S. at least

Please let me know if the petition is satisfactory and the general method for procedure for establishing the proposed new Section. If it is desirable I could prepare a brief statement on "The State of Radio and Electronics in Brazil" similar to the one by Prof. Mahmoud on Egypt in the January 1956 Proceedings on the occasion of the formation of an IRE Section in Egypt.
