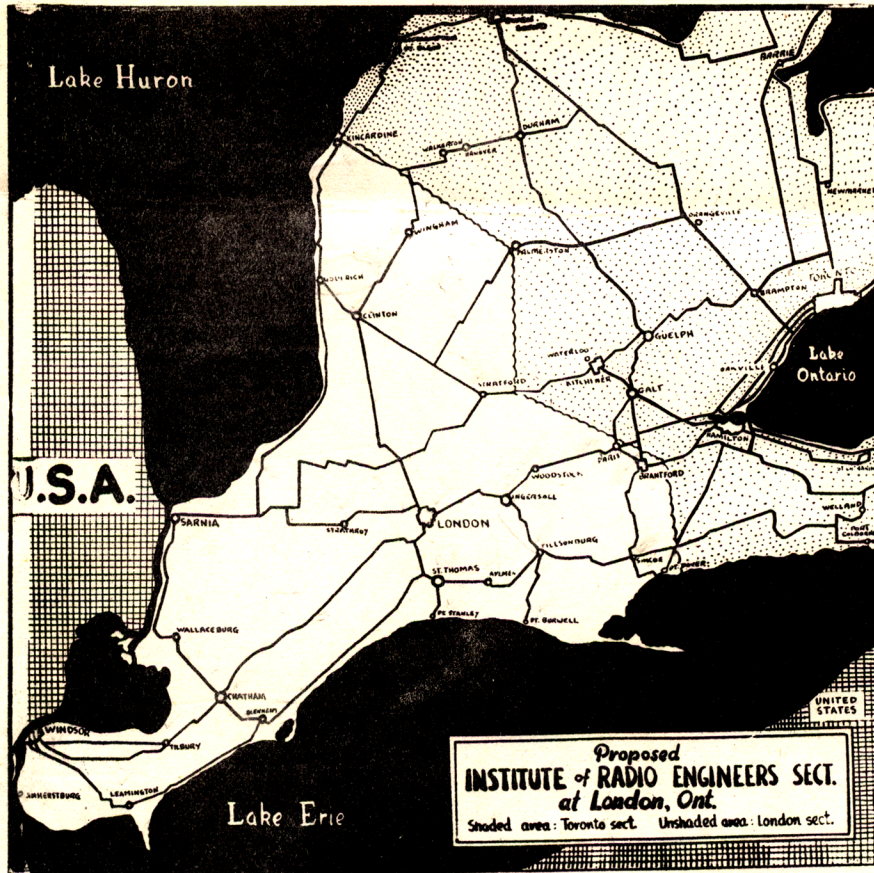

We, the undersigned Corporate Members (Fellows, Members and Associate Members) of the American Institute of Electrical Engineers, hereby petition for the establishment of a Section, to be known as the

" LONDON " ONTARIO "

Section, and to have assigned to it the following territory:

COUNTIES OF HURON, PERTH, LAMBTON, MIDDLESEX, OXFORD, KENT, ELGIN, AND NORFOLK; IN
THE PROVINCE OF ONTARIO, CANADA. (THIS TERRITORY IS PRESENTLY SERVED BY THE LONDON
SUB-SECTION OF THE HAMILTON SECTION.)

(List territory by counties in each State unless an entire State is included.)

EXTRACTS FROM AIEE CONSTITUTION AND BYLAWS

Constitution

C56. Whenever, in the judgment of the Board of Directors, a sufficient number of Fellows, Members and Associate Members shall petition, in writing, these members may form, subject to the Constitution and all By-laws and regulations which may be hereafter prescribed by the Board of Directors, a Section organization for the purpose of more effectually carrying out the aims of the Institute.

C63. Any Section may adopt for its own government such Bylaws to be known as "Section Bylaws" as it may find expedient, provided that no provision thereof shall be incompatible with the Constitution or the Bylaws of the Institute.

Bylaws

B40. A petition for the formation of a Section shall be signed, on a form provided by Institute Headquarters, by not less than 50 members residing within the territorial limits hereinafter prescribed. The Board of Directors may decline to authorize the formation of a Section when in its judgment such an organization would not be compatible with the interests of the Institute.

B41. In the initial Section organization only petitioners shall have the right to vote.

B45. The territory of a Section shall be defined, wherever practical, by county line boundaries. Territorial assignments for the establishment of new Sections or reassignment of Section territories shall be subject to the concurrence of the Sections and Vice-Presidents involved, and the Sections Committee.

B49. A Section whose membership has become 30 or less as of August first, or a Section which shall have held less than four meetings in any fiscal year (May 1 through April 30), shall be formally advised by the Secretary that, if within the next year this situation has not been materially improved, such Section shall become a Subsection (or Division), effective October 1. The Vice-President of the District shall recommend to the Sections Committee the Section to which the Subsection (or Division) shall be assigned.

The Board of Directors may at any time terminate the existence of any Section when in its judgment the interests of the Institute make such action desirable.

I am sorry that my incorrect reference to the Bylaws with regard to the desired Section status for the London Subsection caused the confusion indicated in your letter of August 30.

Actually the approval procedure for the establishment of a Section is much the same as that for a Subsection (to which Bylaw B80.031 c applies) and while the text of my letter was dictated from memory I made the mistake of picking up the wrong reference. Part of the procedure is shown on pages 12 and 13 of the Section Operations Manual and in more detail in the Section Committee Guide. Unfortunately I do not have a spare copy of the Sections Committee Guide but I am attaching a copy of Section X for your information.

Please accept my apologies for the confusion I have caused but unfortunately this is not the only confusion that exists with our very recent move to new quarters. Boxes are still stacked miles high and we are doing well if we can find things we are looking for within a reasonable period of hunting.

Dear Sir:

I have your letters of August 7th and 21st re procedure for securing approval. I have now forwarded the petition to the Hamilton Section for approval and requested that they in turn forward it to the District Officers as suggested.

I would ask for your comments re Bylaws 80.031 c and 80.033 which pertain to this matter. I interpret 80.031 as applying only to Sections wishing to form Sub-sections. Also, I did not feel that the constitution required approval from other than the "Board of Directors", as described on the petition, and possibly as described in Bylaw 80.033, regarding territory of the Section. I had assumed that the territory was acceptable as defined for the Sub-section, and therefore that this would still apply to the new Section.

However, since I have now referred the petition through the channels you suggested, the only clarification needed is the terms of their approval - territory or other.

I do not find any indication that you have obtained the approval of the Hamilton Section and inasmuch as this is the first step to be accomplished, after the petition, I am returning the three pages so that you may submit them for this approval. After receiving the approval of the Hamilton Section the petition, along with notification of their approval, should be sent to the Chairman of the Sections Committee, Mr. H. C. Brem, Allis-Chalmers Mfg. Co., 3240 N. 80 St., Milwaukee 16, Wisconsin, who will process it toward the final approval.

With regard to the proposed name of the Section it would be my personal opinion that retention of London would be very appropriate to maintain continuity of title but more particularly because while you are presently the most Western activity in the Province of Ontario, it is quite possible that some activity might develop in a place such as Port Arthur which would then not really allow you to say that you are the "Western Ontario Section". Mr. R. A. Hackbusch, Vice President of the Institute, spoke to me this week regarding the status of your petition for an Institute Section at London, Ontario.

As you know, the 52 signatures on the forms were those of individuals who had not at the time been elected to membership. With the elections which took place this week, the analysis of those signing the petition, from the standpoint of membership is as follows:

2 Senior Members
45 Associates
47 Signatures of Members in Good Standing
1 Member with Mailing Address Outside
Proposed Area
3 Non-Members
1 Relinquent Associate
52 Total Signatures

From the standpoint of the Institute's Bylaws Section 37, quoted below, your petition is in order with reference to the number of signatures required:

Sec. 37—"A petition for the formation of a Section shall be signed by not fewer than twenty-five (25) Fellows, Senior Members, Members, and Associates with mailing addresses within the proposed territorial limits."

The forms used for your petition made no mention of the proposed territory, other than that the Section would be at London, Ontario. To your

form letter of June 8, a copy of which you submitted for our information, there was attached a map indicating the territory by cities or towns. The Institute defines territories of Sections on the basis of county lines and, in this regard, I quote the first paragraph of Section J from page 9 of our Section Manual, copies of which have been made available to you:

"J. Territories of Sections. For administrative purposes it is necessary to prescribe precisely the area which comprises each Section. An arbitrarily established basis is that the limits shall not exceed sixty miles from the central city which is the headquarters of the Section. In practice we find it necessary to use county lines for our division as the county in which any member is located can be obtained from the Postal Guide. Usually, any county which lies even partly within a sixty-mile radius of the central city is included in the Section territory."

Under the circumstances, it would seem that the following counties in the Province of Ontario could be considered as the territory of the proposed London Section:

Brant	Huron	Serfolk
Bruce	Kent	Oxford
Elgin	Lambton	Perth
Essex	Middlesex	Waterloo

These counties, which are within a sixty-mile radius of London, are merely suggested for your consideration. Because these counties are now included in the official Toronto Section territory, the Institute would require the approval of the latter Section on the indicated or any other territory proposed.

By a copy of this letter, I am informing the officers of the Toronto Section of the situation. It would be preferable if the officers of your group would agree with the Toronto Section executives on the specific counties to be included in the proposed London Section.

You may wish to note that it is the Institute's policy to circularize members, for the preference of Section, in those areas on which there is no agreement between the Sections involved.

Under the circumstances, it is requested that you decide upon the counties to be included and, after checking with the Toronto Section, notify me of the outcome. If the Toronto Section is in agreement with your proposal, it will also be necessary to have their official communication on the matter.

We should appreciate your reply and that of the Toronto Section within the next two weeks.

Our Executive Committee, at its meeting last month, gave consideration to your recent letter, to which I replied on February 29, proposing the formation of an I.R.E. Section at London, Ontario, and instructed me to inform you of the steps to take in the matter.

In this regard I call your attention to Bylaws Section 37, quoted below, which is taken from our Constitution of which a copy is enclosed:

"Sec. 37--A petition for the formation of a Section shall be signed by not fewer than twenty-five (25) Fellows, Senior Members, Members, and Associates residing within the proposed territorial limits."

You will find this Section given on page 4, under the heading, "Sections." Incidentally, I would also suggest that you read the Sections 38-44, inclusive, relating to Sections matters.

As brought out in my February 29 reply, we now have two Sections in Canada, that is, one in Toronto and the other in Montreal. The Toronto Section has the Province of Ontario as its official area, and the Montreal Section the Province of Quebec. While the territory for the proposed territory was not definitely specified, it is assumed that the proposed territory would include a part of one or both of the named Provinces.

Under the circumstances, it would be necessary for you to define the proposed territorial limits and, as indicated in Bylaws Section 37, the signers of the petition should be residents within such area.

In working out the proposed area you may wish to communicate with the chairmen of the Toronto and Montreal Sections, whose names and addresses are given below for your convenience:

Where the area of a proposed Section overlaps that of adjoining Sections, it has been our practice to circularize members in the particular area, by use of a letter-ballot, to determine the preference of those members. If the area of the proposed London (Ontario) Section can be worked out in a manner that is satisfactory to the Toronto and Montreal Sections, it is possible that our Board of Directors would accept that fact in determining the official area of the proposed Section.

Your petition to the Board of Directors should accordingly include the signatures of a minimum of twenty-five members (of Associate or higher grade), and should specifically define the proposed area. I should like to emphasize that the signers should be residents of the proposed territory.

When your petition arrives and if it complies with the Constitutional requirements, it shall be presented to our Board at the meeting immediately following the arrival of the petition, along with any other data that may be submitted on the subject.
