Subject: Approval of Name & Boundary Change for the North Queensland Section to Northern Australia Section

A request was submitted by Grahm Woods to, Update the boundaries of the IEEE North Queensland Section to include the Australian state of Northern Territory and change the name of the North Queensland Section to the IEEE Northern Australia Section.

The boundaries of the proposed Section will be the current boundaries of the North Queensland Section (North Queensland state, north of and including the cities of Mount Isa and Mackay) plus the state of Northern Territory. Postal codes 0800-0899 & 0900-0999

Members in Northern Territories are now assigned to the New South Wales Section. In the six major cities of NT, there are 17 active members, 4 of which have requested to be assigned to the North Queensland Section.

The rationale for the Section change is to provide more efficient services to the members in the Northern parts of Australia and to better align the Section Boundaries within Australia.

FORMATION OF A NORTH QUEENSLAND SECTION

At an informal meeting of IEEE members held in Townsville, it was decided that I should try to form a North Queensland section. Presently, members in North Queensland are included in the Queensland Section, but by being at least 1100km by air away from Brisbane our members can hardly be expected to attend regular meetings in Brisbane.

Information from the Queensland section is that we have about 40 members in Townsville, Mt. Isa and Cairns and there are many student members (at least 19) not included in these numbers.

Townsville is closer to Port Moresby in Papua New Guinea than to Brisbane and we believe that the logical boundaries for a region based in North Queensland should be North from latitude 21, just South of Mackay, covering the state of Queensland and also to include Papua New Guinea (see the attached map). The North Queensland region is a service region to Papua New Guinea.


Townsville is the best centre to cover the North Queensland region because of the location of James Cook University which has an Electrical and Electronic Engineering Department. Each year there are students who are encouraged to join IEEE and we feel that about 60-80% of the graduating students become IEEE student members. The students do not stay in the region as many of them go to other centres in Australia. Over the past 10 years we have provided about 120 members (our estimate). We feel that we could possibly improve the recruitment if we had a local section.

To be able to petition for a new North Queensland Section we need support from you in order to mail to each member in this area.

* My estimate of the cost of preparing letters to go to each of the 40 known members is \$A40 which would cover postage and photocopying. Typing and placing the letters into envelopes we can arrange at no extra cost. There may be additional members on the added list since 1988 which could take the potential members to 60 which would require a further \$A20. We should be grateful if you could advance me an amount of \$A60 in order to circulate the proposal to members. Alternatively, if you are unable to make an advance, we should be grateful if you would make a written undertaking to underwrite the costs (i.e. reimburse me) when I can provide the appropriate receipts.

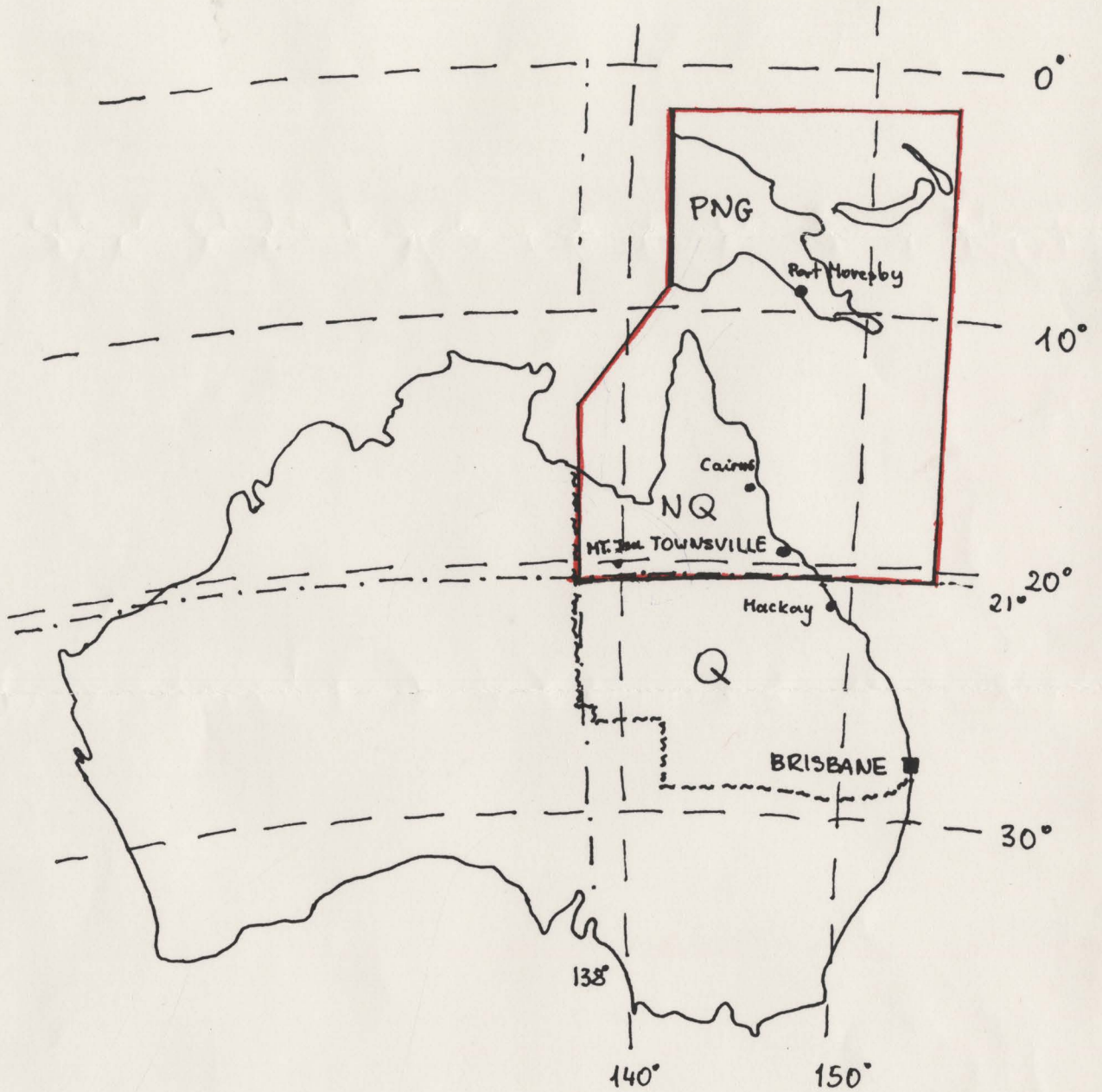

Enclosed are signatures of 24 IEEE members from Townsville and the North Queensland area.



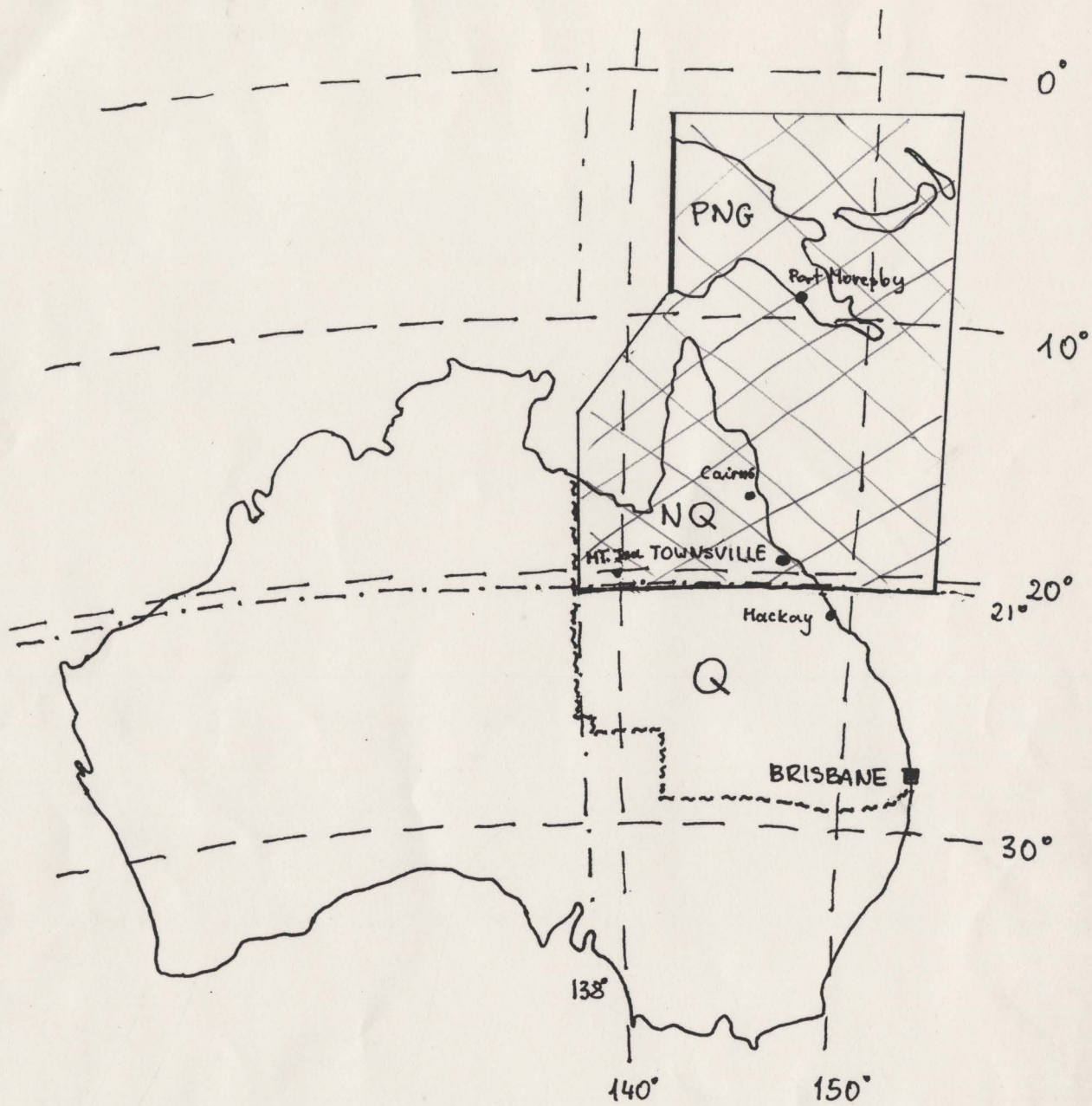


