



#### FORMATION OF A NORTH QUEENSLAND SECTION

At an informal meeting of IEEE members held in Townsville, it was decided that I should try to form a North Queensland section. Presently, members in North Queensland are included in the Queensland Section, but by being at least 1100km by air away from Brisbane our members can hardly be expected to attend regular meetings in Brisbane.

Information from the Queensland section is that we have about 40 members in Townsville, Mt. Isa and Cairns and there are many student members (at least 19) not included in these numbers.

Townsville is closer to Port Moresby in Papua New Guinea than to Brisbane and we believe that the logical boundaries for a region based in North Queensland should be North from latitude 21, just South of Mackay, covering the state of Queensland and also to include Papau New Guinea (see the attached map). The North Queensland region is a service region to Papua New Guinea.

Townsville is the best centre to cover the North Queensland region because of the location of James Cook University which has an Electrical and Electronic Engineering Department. Each year there are students who are encouraged to join IEEE and we feel that about 60-80% of the graduating students become IEEE student members. The students do not stay in the region as many of them go to other centres in Australia. Over the past 10 years we have provided about 120 members (our estimate). We feel that we could possibly improve the recruitment if we had a local section.

To be able to petition for a new North Queensland Section we need support from you in order to mail to each member in this area.

\* My estimate of the cost of preparing letters to go to each of the 40 known members is \$A40 which would cover postage and photocopying. Typing and placing the letters into envelopes we can arrange at no extra cost. 

#### FORMATION OF A NORTH QUEENSLAND SUB-SECTION

In accordance with the IEEE bylaws (January 1989) Clause 405 Sub-sections, the IEEE members petitioning on the attached sheets request the formation of an IEEE sub-section to be located at Townsville in Queensland.

Enclosed are signatures of 24 IEEE members from Townsville and the North Queensland area.

Information from the Queensland section is that we have about 40 members in Townsville, Mt. Isa and Cairns and there are many student members (at least 19) not included in these numbers.

Townsville is closer to Port Moresby in Papua New Guinea than to Brisbane and we believe that the logical boundaries for a region based in North Queensland should be North from latitude 21, just South of Mackay, covering the state of Queensland and also to include Papua New Guinea (see the attached map). The North Queensland region is a service region to Papua New Guinea.

Townsville is the best centre to cover the North Queensland region because of the location of James Cook University which has an IEEE Student Branch in

Electrical and Computer Engineering Department. Each year there are students who are encouraged to join IEEE and we feel that about 60-80% of the graduating students become IEEE student members. The students do not stay in the region as many of them go to other centres in Australia. Over the past 10 years we have provided about 120 members (our estimate). We feel that we could possibly improve the recruitment if we had a local section.






