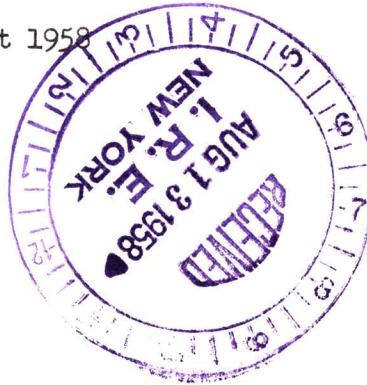

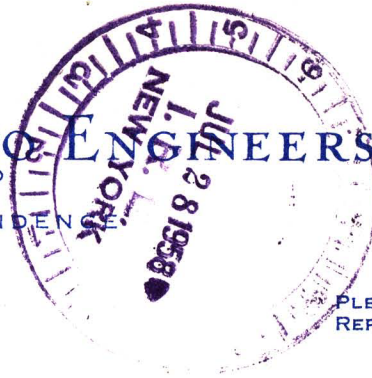

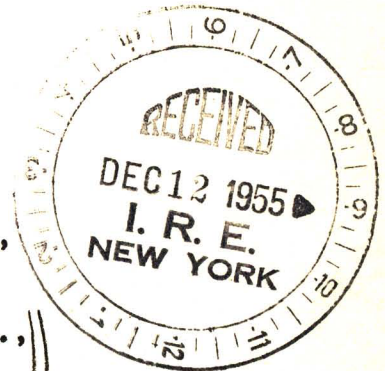

Dear Miss Sirjane:-

(1) Thank you for your letter of October 17, 1955. The proposed new sub-section is to be known simply as "Quebec Sub-Section (of the Montreal Section) of the Institute of Radio Engineers!" The part in brackets may be dropped if the remainder of the name is sufficiently explicit. We have informed Dr. Boisvert of the news.

(2) The Executive Committee of the Montreal Section has nominated Mr. John A. Collins, 37 Chester St., Valois, Quebec, Canada, to be Chairman of the Committee on Professional Groups.
