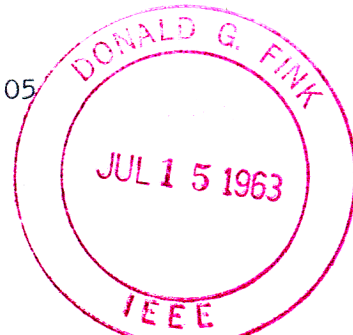

We are enclosing statement of Tom B. Stenis, AIEE Chairman, and L. A. Pease, IRE Chairman, certifying to the intent of the Lubbock IRE and Panhandle-Plains AIEE Sections to merge into I.E.E.E. You will note that two sections have emerged from the Panhandle-Plains Section (the Panhandle Section is covered by separate letter; this letter pertinent to South Plains Section only).

The South Plains Section, in addition, wishes to establish a Permian Basin Subsection.

Also enclosed you will find copies of list of officers, statement of financial status, and statement of counties in Texas and New Mexico which comprise the South Plains Section and Permian Basin Subsection.

You will find copy of proposed constitution and bylaws.

We are enclosing list of officers for Permian Basin Subsection and statement of finances, counties in Texas comprising this subsection, and constitution and bylaws.

Dear Professor Spuhler:

We have checked the records of our payments to you and find the following situation. On August 24, 1951, we sent the Amarillo-Lubbock Sub-section a payment of \$84.00. This was computed as \$10.00 for each of seven meetings due you, and 50 cents each for an average of 28 members.

For the year 1952 you are due \$10.00 for each of the first five meetings held and 55 cents per member on an average of 26 members for a total of \$64.30. The rebate rate was increased due to the fact that the rebate rate to the Dallas-Fort Worth Section was increased during this period also. For the year 1953 we assume that five meetings will be held and this would mean that we should send an additional \$50.00 to cover these meetings for this calendar year. You now have 26 members, excluding students, for which no rebate is made, so we are sending \$14.30 to cover this.

This then means that we owe the sub-section a total of \$128.60 for the years 1952-1953.

On January 26, 1953 I mailed the sub-section a check in the amount of \$50.00 as an advance payment until proper accounting could be accomplished. I am enclosing now a check in the amount of \$78.60 which is the total rebate due you at this date and which will bring our account with you to a current condition through December 31, 1953. Naturally if your average membership increases during the next six months, this condition will be re-considered at the rate of 55 cents per member per calendar year for each member added.

On January 29, 1953 Mr. Arnett, Chairman of the Dallas-Fort Worth Section wrote to Mr. McKinney who was then your secretary outlining the geographical boundaries as follows: All of the northwest corner of Texas bounded on the west by New Mexico, on the north by Oklahoma, and on the south and east by and including these counties; Childress, Cottle, King, Stonewall, Fisher, Nolan, Coks, Sterling, Glasscock, Midland, and Ector.

Inasmuch as we have had no objection, we are informing headquarters by copy of this letter that your subsection is officially defined by the statement above.

I am sending with this letter a set of cards which have been prepared today from our mailing list cards furnished us by headquarters. These cards cover all persons listed in your defined area. I am going to ask Mr. Bullock the new secretary of the section effective July 1, 1953 to continue sending address cards and change of address information to you so that your file may also be current in this regard. If there are further questions on this, please do contact me and I shall try to take care of it real soon. Thanks a lot. Regards


Dear Mr. Lee:

I am pleased to send you this letter along with a copy of a letter which I have written to Mr. Lee of Lubbock concerning the request of members of the I.R.E. in that area for formation of the Lubbock Section of I.R.E.

You were at the regular Section Meeting of the Dallas-Fort Worth Section when we discussed this problem and you heard the unanimous approval of the Section for these people to go ahead and form their own activity, and the approval of our Section to release the area involved and so capably outlined by Mr. Lee in his letter to me dated April 22 along with a map which has been properly prepared showing this area.
