

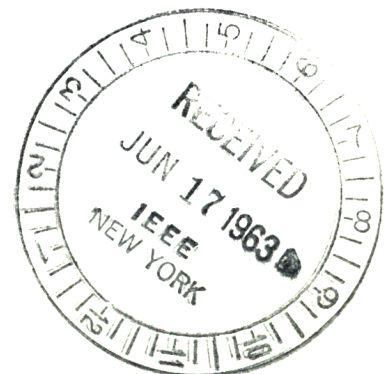
Attached you will find a copy of a letter from D. F. Folland, establishing the Utah Section of IEEE.

The Salt Lake City Section of IRE and the Utah Section of AIEE plan to merge into the Utah Section of IEEE on June 5, 1963. When this merger takes place, the boundaries of the new section will be essentially that proposed by the National Committee, with the following exceptions:

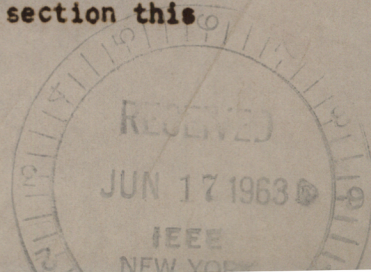
1. Washington and Iron Counties of Utah will be assigned to the Las Vegas Section. This was agreed upon with the Las Vegas Section at the Committee Meeting held in San Diego on April 26, 1963.

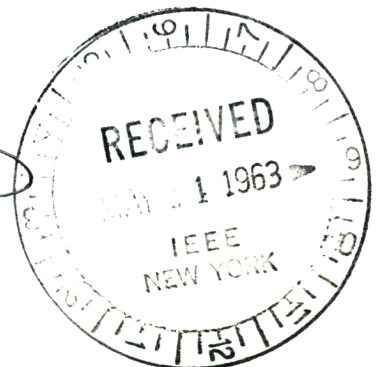
When general mailing lists are requested in the future, they should be based on the new boundaries and include all IEEE members within these boundaries.

Omission of Park County, Wyoming, from the Utah Section of IEEE was an error on our part. This should be included.

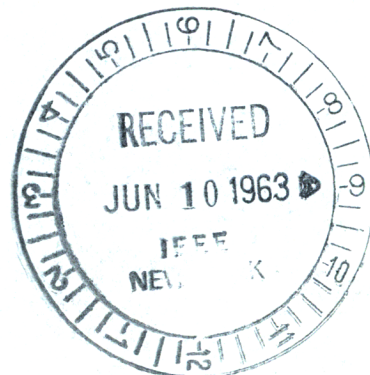

Dear Sir:

I have the honor of notifying you that the Board of Directors of the Institute at its meeting held in Chicago on March 9, 1917 authorized the organization of a Section in Salt Lake City, to be known as UTAH SECTION OF THE AMERICAN INSTITUTE OF ELECTRICAL ENGINEERS.

A call may now be issued to all of the petitioners and to any other persons interested, for a preliminary meeting for the purpose of organizing the Section. At this preliminary meeting only the petitioners have the right to vote. As you will probably consider the adoption of some form of by-laws, we enclose herewith a pamphlet containing suggestions prepared by this office several years ago, which may be used in their present form or modified to suit your convenience. We also enclose copy of a letter issued to the chairmen and secretaries last fall containing information for newly elected officers. Under separate cover we are mailing you two copies of the Year Book containing the constitution and by-laws, lists of members and other information regarding the Institute, twenty-five membership booklets and a supply of the forms to be used by the local secretary for carrying on the work.

Your attention is called to Sections 58 to 73 inclusive of the by-laws, relating to Sections. As you will note by reference to section 63, the territory of the Section is limited to points within sixty miles of the meeting place. All towns within this distance of Salt Lake City, therefore, are within the Utah Section's territory. The Section can, if it so desires, extend its mailing list to include towns beyond the sixty mile limit, but an extension of territory beyond sixty miles for financial purposes (see section 71) could only be made upon the recommendation of the Sections Committee and the approval of the Board of Directors. In a day or two we will send you a set of cards bearing the names and addresses of all Institute members within the sixty mile limit, and for which the Section will receive credit in computing its appropriation for the year.

- Signatures of at least six (6) IEEE Members, other than Students, who are Members of the Section(s) involved and who indicate they will join the Affinity Group, if established.

The petition shall be submitted to the Section Executive Committee for written approval and forwarded with this written approval to the IEEE Managing Director, Regional Activities.

Regional Activities staff will review the petition and work with the organizer to resolve any discrepancies. The Affinity Group shall be considered established after the IEEE Managing Director, Regional Activities has ascertained that the Regional Director and the IEEE parent entity have no objection to its formation.

The IEEE Managing Director, Regional Activities will notify the Regional Activities Board, the IEEE sponsoring entity, and the Section Chair on behalf of the IEEE Executive Director.

TO FORM A JOINT AFFINITY GROUP

The requirements are the same as for a single Affinity Group, except that not less than three of the six signatures on the petition shall be members of each of the parent entities involved.

The status of an Affinity Group may be changed from single to joint, or vice versa or from one joint combination to another, without submission of a petition.
