Attached is petition requesting approval of formation of a Section of the IRE to be known as the LAS VEGAS SECTION, to include the following counties in the state of Nevada:

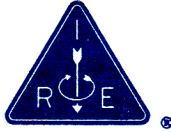

We are pleased to acknowledge receipt of your letter of March 22 and petition for the formation of an IRE Las Vegas Section.

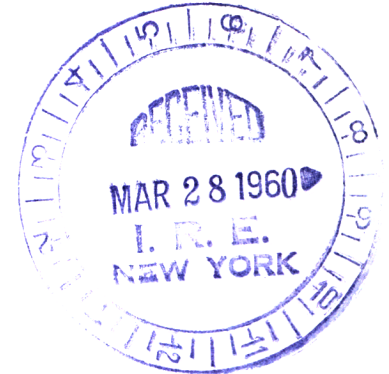

We have held two organizational meetings so far and out of this has come the following selection of officers:

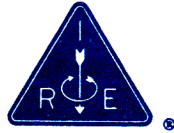

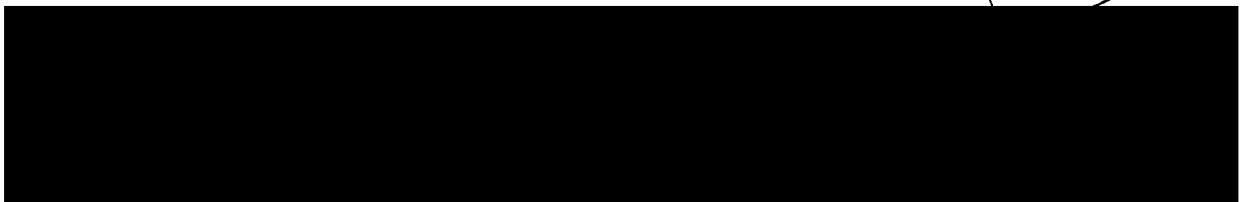
