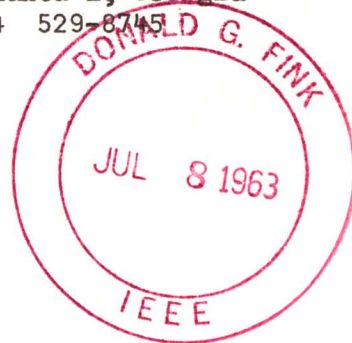


By mutual agreement of the abutting sections the counties

c. Number of Meetings - a minimum of ^{FIVE (5)} ~~ten (10)~~ monthly meetings will be held annually.

d. Election - will be conducted in accordance with the constitution set forth in the IEEE Sections Manual. Election to section offices below Chairman does not establish by implication or otherwise any pre-emptive rights of progression thru the offices. (eg. Secretary become Vice-Chairman at next election, etc.)
