IEEE Sri Lanka section was officially formed at the end of year 2004. A.2 Financial Report

Last year IEEE Sri Lanka section received SL Rs 324 000 (~USD 3200) as the section rebate, which was the main income. The balance from the last year is SL Rs.400,000. This year the income from the workshops will be used to cover the expenses of the workshop and for promoting membership development programs. The income from the conferences could not be estimated as the number of participants is yet to be unknown.
