We are pleased to note from your March 17 letter that the newly-established Newfoundland-Labrador Subsection will be holding an election of officers next week.


Just as soon as the names of the Officers are reported to us, we will send the Subsection Chairman and Secretary a copy of the IEEE Section Manual.




