

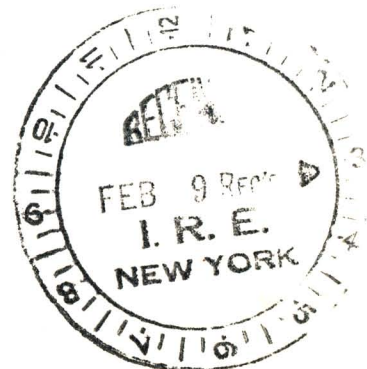

Subject: A Petition for the Establishment of a Sub-Section

We, the undersigned\*, in accordance with the Institute of Radio Engineers, Inc. bylaws; Section 70-3, paragraph a; hereby submit this petition to establish the Palm Beach Sub-Section of the Miami Section of the Institute of Radio Engineers, Inc.

The following factors are offered in support of this petition for Sub-Section Status:

1. NAME and HEADQUARTERS

The name of the proposed sub-section to be the "Palm Beach Sub-Section" with headquarters in West Palm Beach, Palm Beach County, Florida.

2. BOUNDARIES

The area included in the proposed sub-section to be the following counties of South Florida:  
Martin and Palm Beach

3. MEMBERS

There are 35 members residing in the proposed area according to the latest membership list from the Miami Section. To date, 28 members have signed a statement supporting a new sub-section in the Palm Beach area. \*

4. GROWTH

The Palm Beach area must have a sound, strong, and alert IRE Sub-Section to provide the proper service for our community of the near future. The proposed area, which had a population of 125,000 persons in 1950, is expected to have a population of around 250,000 in 1960, and by 1970 approximately 500,000. \*\*

The ground work for this sub-section has been established over the past twelve months. The first membership poll revealed a membership list of 10 members; today there are over 30, and we expect to approach 100 by 1962 based upon present growth and convenience of attending local meetings. The first informal organizational meeting of the members and interested engineering personnel indicated 24 would be interested in joining the IRE if regular monthly meetings could be held locally. \*\*\*

5. OTHER SOCIETIES

Notice must be taken of the success enjoyed by the other professional societies in this area. There are very active sections of the American Rocket Society, the Florida Engineering Society (National Society of Professional Engineers), and the American Society of Mechanical Engineers. Other sub-sections showing rapid growth are the American Institute of Electrical Engineers, and the American Society of Civil Engineers.

6. MEETINGS

A plan was formulated at our organizational meeting, December 6, 1960, to hold regular monthly meetings from September to June of each year with the June meeting utilized as a special annual meeting with wives and guests. Leading restaurants and special club rooms are available in this area for these meetings.

7. BY-LAWS

The proposed section By-Laws are identical to the Miami Section and in agreement with our National By-Laws.

8. OFFICERS


The persons holding the offices of the proposed sub-section are representatives from a cross-section of our industrial group from large to small; Pratt & Whitney Aircraft and Franklin Systems, Inc. \*\*\*\*


