The territories of the Sections are denoted on the attached.

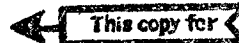

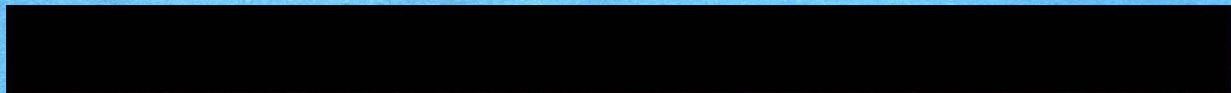
